Vote By Absentee

If you will be away from home during the election or prefer to vote by mail, please call the Elections Office to request an absentee ballot, (386) 313-4170. Absentee ballots are NOT forwarded by the US Postal Service, an accurate mailing address is required.

How To Vote

Voters at the polls will receive a paper ballot inside a secrecy folder. To vote. completely fill in the oval next to your choice.

If you make a mistake, don't hesitate to ask for a new ballot. If you erase or make other marks, your vote may not count.

Vote Early

Early voting begins 10 days prior to the election and ends the Saturday before Election Day. Any registered and eligible voter in the county may vote early.

Register To Vote

You must be registered to vote at least 29 days prior to Election Day in order to be eligible to vote in the election. You may register in person at the Elections Office or the voter application is available online. Any new registrations received after the deadline will be deferred until after the election.

Have you moved? Change your address with the Elections Office prior to Election Day to avoid delays at the polls. If you are moving from a different Florida county to Flagler county and have not changed your address prior to Election Day, you will be required to vote a provisional ballot at the polls.
