Disturbance Domestic (Delayed) / 16-95839 / Richland Lane, Palm Coast. Subject 1 (S1) Charles Nicodemus continuously battered V1 over the past week. S1 transported to the Flagler County jail without incident. See report by Deputy R. Finn for further.

Disturbance Domestic / 16-95925 / Farragut Drive, Palm Coast. Physical disturbance between a man and a woman. S1, Gabriel Pardo, left the residence prior to law enforcement arrival, but was later spotted parked in the Palm Coast Lanes parking lot. Because S1 was believed to be armed, Corp. Reckenwald began giving PA command for S1 to exit his vehicle. S1 eventually complied and was taken into custody without further incident. S1 was armed with a semi-automatic handgun with three (3) fully loaded magazines. S1 was transported to the Flagler County jail without incident. See report by Deputy R. Finn for further.

Disturbance Domestic / 16-95918 / Woodworth Drive, Palm Coast. Physical disturbance between two people -- both considered suspect/victim. Each identified the other as the primary aggressor. Due to lack of evidence and witnesses, no arrests made. Both subjects were separated and charges will be forwarded against both. See report by Deputy Parthemore for further.
