Part One UCR Crimes: Type of Call / Case Number / Address / Case Summary

Burglary-Residential/29732-16/PineLynn Lane, Palm Coast. Victim 1 (V-1) reported that between 12 a.m. and 1 a.m. on this date, two unidentified black males entered her screen porch and stole her brown Panama Jack beach cruiser bicycle.

Non-Part One Crimes: Missing Persons, Traffic Fatality, Use of Force, Weapons

Traffic Stop/29612-16/Belle Terre Parkway & Barrister Lane, Palm Coast. Defendant 1 (D-1) Stephen Lane Whatley W/M 8-27-92 was arrested for driving on a suspended license (2nd offense). D-1 was additionally charged with introduction of contraband into corrections facility, poss. heroin, methamphetamine, and drug paraphernalia. D-1 was transported to the Flagler County jail for processing without incident.

Baker Act/29656-16/Pershing Lane, Palm Coast. Notification/welfare check on an adult male resident revealed that his home was flooded, shell casings were found throughout the home, and the residence was in complete disarray. The male was found lying on the floor of his bedroom and was treated by Rescue and transported to FHF under a Baker Act.

Welfare Check/29768-16/ State Road 100 E (Michaels Craft Store parking lot), Palm Coast. Customers noticed an infant inside an unattended vehicle. The windows were cracked open approximately one inch, but the vehicle was not running. The outside temperature was approximately 75 degrees F. As the responding units were arriving on scene, the mother of the 6-month-old boy arrived back at the vehicle and unlocked it. The child was checked by Rescue, and appeared to be unharmed.
