#### Part One UCR Crimes: Type of Call / Case Number / Address / Case Summary

Burglary Residential/ 2016-51701/ Zone 5/ Seward Trail W, Palm Coast. An adult female called 9-1-1 stating she was at home with her two young children when a male suspect began checking her doors and windows. The victim (V1) stated she put her children in a room and retrieved a firearm while the suspect pried open the rear slider to enter the home. V1 stated the suspect entered her living room while still holding a crowbar; she pointed the firearm at him and ordered him to leave. The suspect left in a red SUV and the victim took a picture of the suspect vehicle and provided the tag to dispatch. Units followed the vehicle at a safe distance until Daytona Beach PD and VCSO conducted a traffic stop in Daytona without incident. Suspect was taken into custody after a positive ID.
