Disturbance Physical/ 2016-60658/ Ocean Crest Drive, Palm Coast. Two male subjects reported being involved in a physical disturbance near the property's main event lawn. The pair described a mutual combat altercation between the two of them and four unidentified white males. The two were under the influence of alcohol and sworn statements could not be taken from them at this time.
