Thank you for submitting your application to participate in this year's Fabulous 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade in the City of Flagler Beach. We are proud to host the holiday parade and fireworks display, which has become the single largest one (1) day event in all of Flagler County.

In an effort to ensure public safety at this year's parade, as well as future parades in Flagler Beach, the Police Department and the Flagler Beach Rotary Club are respectfully requesting that all event participants agree <u>not to throw candy</u>. The throwing of candy from vehicles, floats, or by walkers encourages spectators, more specifically small children, to run into the roadway, which threatens their safety and the safety of others. <u>However, the direct hand-to-hand passing of candy from event participants on foot to spectators located off the approved parade route will be authorized</u>.

During this year's parade, Officers of the Flagler Beach Police Department will be monitoring the parade for cooperation and compliance with this request. Any participant not in compliance may jeopardize their participation in future parades.

Thousands of spectators flock to Flagler Beach for our July 4<sup>th</sup> and Christmas parades, bringing positive local and regional attention to our beautiful City. This request is being made not to diminish the spirit, pageantry or revelry of the event, but rather to enlist your assistance in securing an increased atmosphere of safety in which participants and spectators alike can truly enjoy all our holiday parades have to offer.

Your pledge not to throw candy is just one (1) key to making these events as safe as possible. Thank you in advance for your understanding and compliance with this request.
