- * Beginning January 1, 2016
- * Single Membership: \$200 each
- * Family-1 or 2 parents: \$200/year/adult (includes 0-12 free)
 0-12 free, but must be accompanied by a parent
- * Age 13+: \$50 each but must be part of a family package
- * Student Rate (high school and college), 13+:\$100/year
- * Summer Rate for May-August: \$100
- * Monthly Rate: \$30

Prorated Membership

- * Prorated Membership Costs beginning January 1, 2016:
- * January 1-March 31: 100% of annual cost
- * April 1-June 30: 75% of annual cost
- * July 1-September 30: 50% of annual cost
- * October 1-December 31: 25% of annual cost
