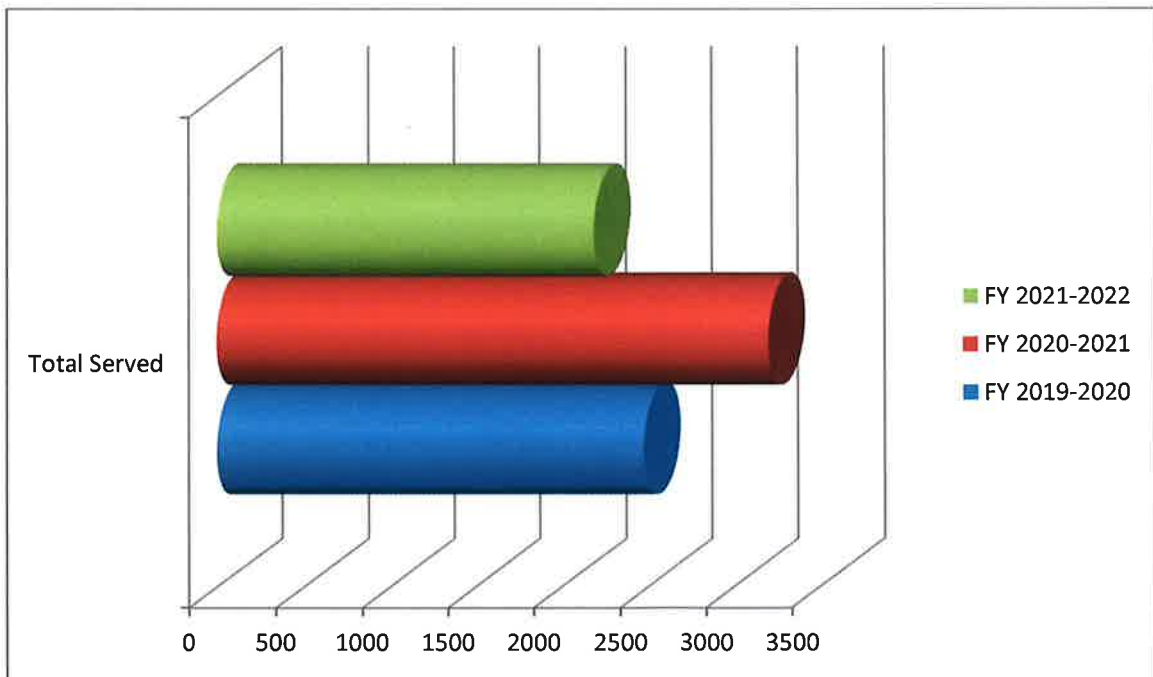

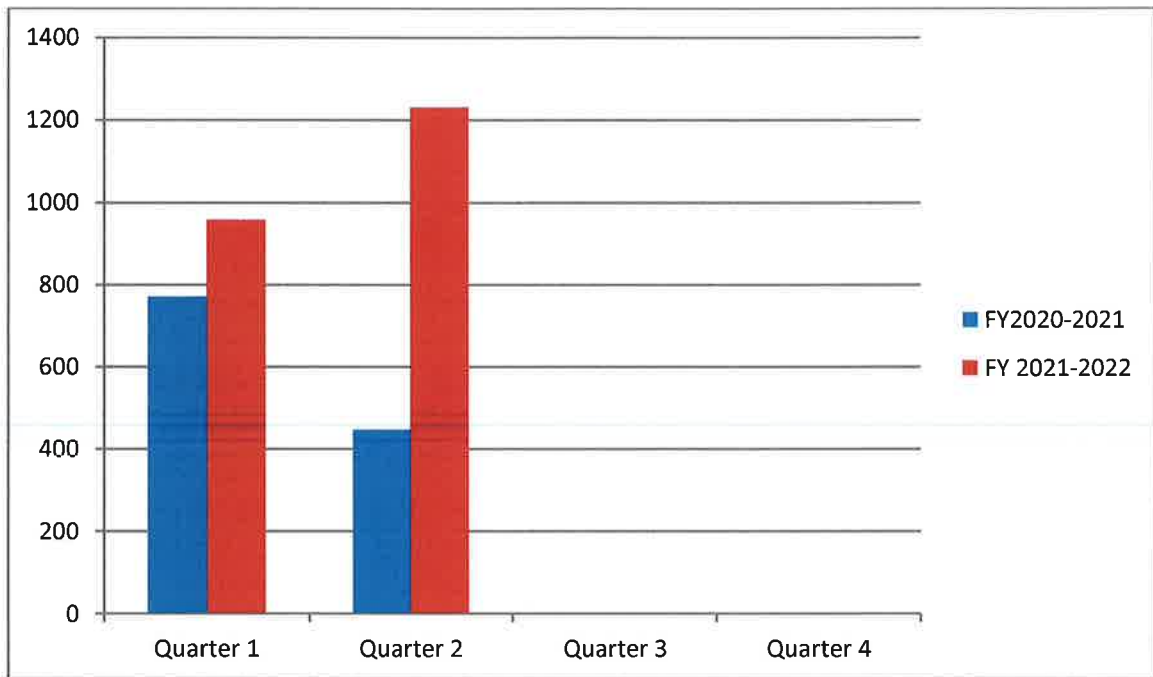
Comparison of FY 2019-2020, FY 2020-2021 and FY 2021-2022

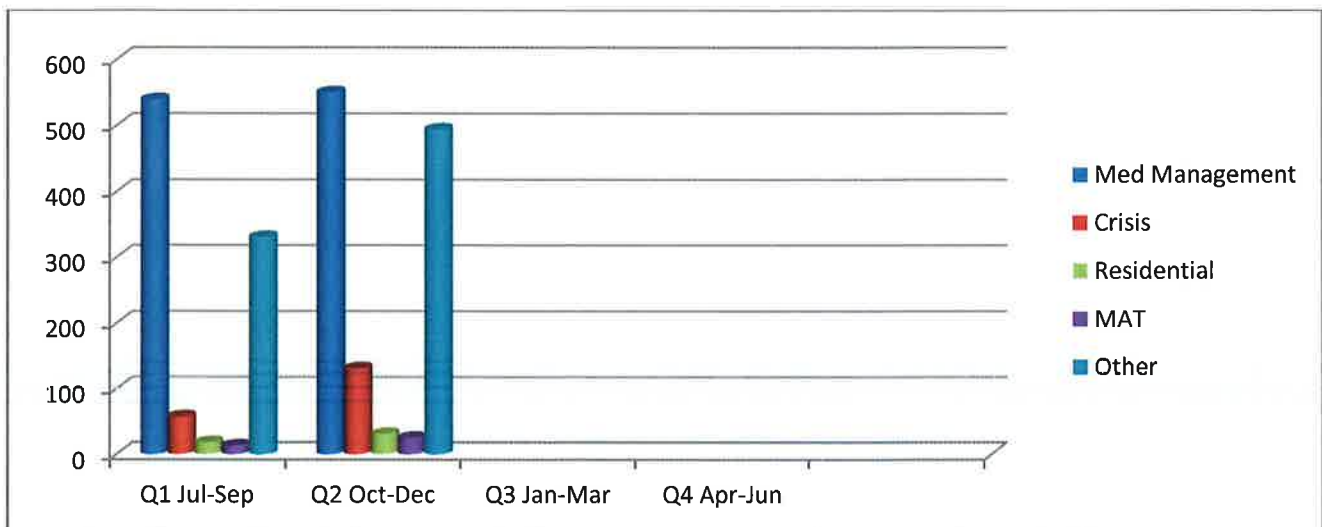
**Comparison of Q1- FY 20/21 and 21/22**

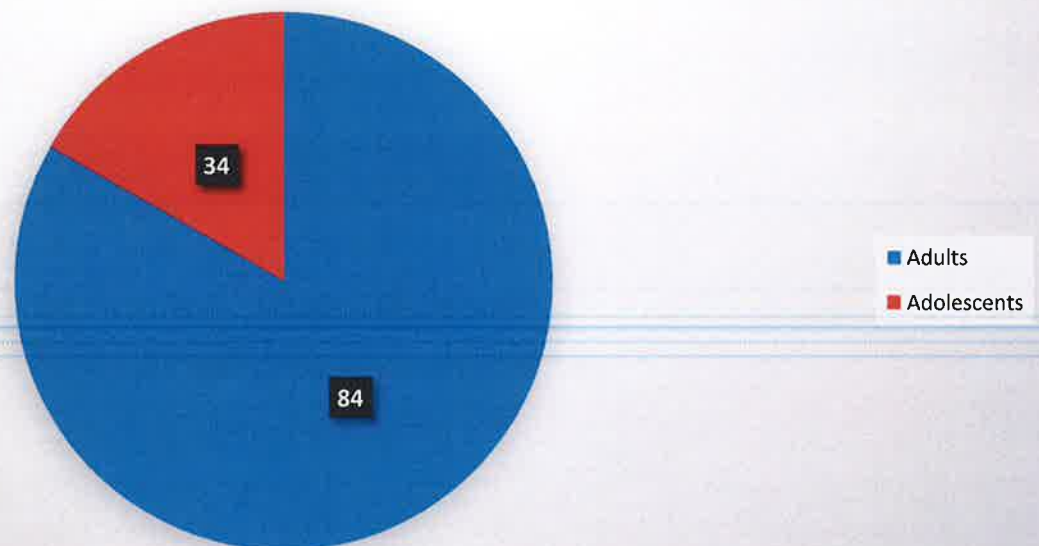
SMA Comparison of Services over FY 2021-2022
