Upon contact a strong smell of Marijuana was emitting from the interior, and vehicle was searched. Officers located a pipe commonly used to smoke Marijuana, along with several Alprazolam pills, that were not prescribed. Subject was transported to the Flagler Beach Police Department to complete paperwork, and then transported to the Flagler County Inmate Facility. Subject was a juvenile, and the Department of Juvenile Justice advised to issue the Juvenile a Notice to Appear. Juvenile was released to her parent. Report made. No arrest details due to her being a juvenile.
