BOLO: BOLO for a Brett Gregory Bosier (W/M, D.O.B.: 8/14/89, FL DL # B260067892940) who made suicidal statements to harm himself. Brett is 5'10" tall, approximately 175 lbs., with shoulder length sandy blonde hair, facial hair, and was last seen possibly wearing black shorts, black baseball cap, and a black hoodie with an American flag on the front of it. Brett does not have access to a vehicle, and was last seen on foot in the area of 2444 S. Oceanshore Blvd Flagler Beach FL 32136. Brett made suicidal statements to his finance to harm himself and stated that he had taken approximately twenty (20) Adderall and no longer wished to live.
