IN A PRIMARY ELECTION... If you are registered as a **DEMOCRAT**, you will vote a Democratic ballot and the NonPartisan races. ★ If you are registered as a **REPUBLICAN**, you will vote a Republican ballot and the NonPartisan races. ★ If you are registered with **NO PARTY AFFILIATION** or with a **MINOR POLITICAL PARTY**, you will vote a NonPartisan ballot. ★ Where there is a **UNIVERSAL PRIMARY CONTEST**, all candidates in a race have the same party affiliation with no opposition in the General Election and **ALL** eligible voters may vote in the Primary Election for that race.

Flagler County uses an optical scanner to read your ballot. You must completely fill in the oval in order for your vote to count. Any other mark may not be read by the scanner.

INCORRECT

DO NOT CHECK, MARK AN "X" OR CIRCLE THE OVAL.

BEFORE YOU GO TO VOTE:

★ Take your driver's license or another acceptable form of photo and signature identification with you (F.S. 101.043).

★ If you do not have acceptable photo and signature identification, you will be allowed to vote a provisional ballot.

★ If you have recently moved, please be sure that you change your address with the Elections Office BEFORE Election Day to avoid a delay at the polls.

★ Check your voter information card for the precinct number and location of your polling place.
