IN A PRIMARY ELECTION... If you are registered as a **DEMOCRAT**, you will vote a Democratic ballot and the NonPartisan races. ★ If you are registered as a **REPUBLICAN**, you will vote a Republican ballot and the NonPartisan races. ★ If you are registered with **NO PARTY AFFILIATION** or with a **MINOR POLITICAL PARTY**, you will vote a NonPartisan ballot. ★ Where there is a **UNIVERSAL PRIMARY CONTEST**, all candidates in a race have the same party affiliation with no opposition in the General Election and **ALL** eligible voters may vote in the Primary Election for that race.



The voter records his/her vote by completely filling in the oval next to the candidate or issue by using the pen provided in the voting booth. If you make a mistake, don't hesitate to ask for a new ballot. If you erase or make other marks, your vote may not count.
