DEADLINE FOR PARTY CHANGES
AND NEW REGISTRATIONS:
JULY 28, 2014

- ★ If you are registered as a **REPUBLICAN**, you will vote a Republican ballot with all the NonPartisan races.
- ★ If you are registered as a **DEMOCRAT**, you will vote a Democratic ballot with all the NonPartisan races.
- ★ If you are registered with **NO PARTY AFFILIATION** or with a **MINOR POLITICAL PARTY**, you will vote a NonPartisan ballot.

UNIVERSAL PRIMARY CONTEST: All candidates in a race have the same party affiliation with no opposition in the General Election and ALL eligible voters may vote in the Primary Election for that race.

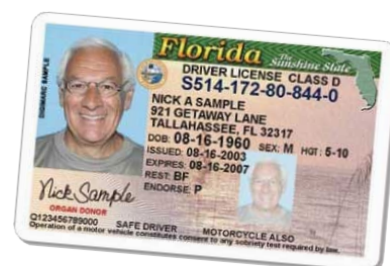

Florida Law requires each voter to present both photo **and** signature identification at the polls:

- Florida Driver's License
- Florida ID card (issued by DHSMV)
- U.S. Passport
- Debit or Credit Card
- Military ID or Student ID
- Retirement Center or Neighborhood Association ID
- Public Assistance ID

Expired ID's will not be accepted.
