### Attention Voters: Florida is A Closed Primary State

A closed Primary means you must be a registered voter in the party for which the Primary is being held. All registered voters, regardless of party affiliation, may vote the nonpartisan ballot and Universal Primary Contests. Deadline to register to vote or change your party affiliation: **July 20, 2020.**

If you are registered as a **REPUBLICAN**, you will vote a Republican ballot which also includes all nonpartisan contests and two Universal Primary Contests.

If you are registered as a **DEMOCRAT**, you will vote a Democratic ballot which also includes all nonpartisan contests and two Universal Primary Contests.

**ALL REGISTERED VOTERS** regardless of political party affiliation may vote for nonpartisan contests and two Universal Primary Contests. **All voters who reside in the City of Palm Coast** may vote for the city races on this ballot.

#### Which contests will be decided in this Primary?

There are two Universal Primary Contests for partisan offices this year. These candidates will appear on all ballots and the contest will be decided in this Primary because they face no opposition in the General Election. All voters are eligible to vote for these two contests:

- Public Defender, 7th Judicial Circuit
- Board of County Commissioners, District 3

Nonpartisan contests with two candidates are always decided in a Primary Election. All voters are eligible to vote for all nonpartisan contests.

- Circuit Judge, 7th Judicial Circuit, Group 6
- Circuit Judge, 7th Judicial Circuit, Group 27
- School Board, District 1
- School Board, District 5

Nonpartisan contests with more than two candidates can be decided in a Primary if one candidate receives a majority of the vote (over 50%). All voters are eligible to vote for all nonpartisan contests.

### VOTING IN PERSON?

*Be prepared and stay safe to prevent the spread of COVID-19.*

#### What you should do:

- If you have moved recently, update your address before you vote. Call (386) 313-4170 to change your address.
- Bring a valid form of photo and signature ID with you.
- Use this Sample Ballot to make your choices and bring it with you to the polls.
- Bring your own black ballpoint pen to use on your official ballot if you do not feel comfortable using the pen provided at your polling location.
- Bring a face covering and wear it during your voting experience, unless you are unable to do so because of a health condition.
- Limit conversation and be patient while waiting in line and also inside the polling room.

#### What we will do:

- Provide a clean polling room by routinely disinfecting touched surfaces such as equipment and voting booths.
- Provide hand sanitizer for all voters and election workers.
- Provide personal protective equipment for all election workers.
- Provide a single-use stylus for voters to use when signing the signature pad.
- Encourage social distancing.

#### How To Vote

Use only the marking device provided or a black pen. If you make a mistake, don't hesitate to ask for a new ballot. If you erase or make other marks, your vote may not count.

Please take this sample ballot with you when voting in person and use it as a reference.

Did you know several contests will be decided in this election? All registered voters in the county may vote for these contests, including voters without a party affiliation and those who are registered with a minor party. Voter turnout for Primary elections in Flagler County averages less than 30%. All elections are important, don't skip this Primary!

You may choose to vote either by mail, at any early voting site or at your assigned precinct on Election Day. This sample ballot shows the ballot for the entire county, not just your precinct. Your representative districts, precinct number and polling location are shown on your Voter Information Card. If you have moved since the last time you voted and did not update your registration, please call the Elections Office and change your address over the phone. Your precinct number and Election Day polling location may have changed.

## Vote On Election Day

## Vote-By-Mail

Request your mail ballot using the form below or call the Elections Office at (386) 313-4170. All voted mail ballots must be received by the Elections Office by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. A postmark does not extend this deadline. Drop boxes for mail ballots will be available at all early voting sites during polling hours. Ballots can also be returned directly to the Supervisor of Elections office in Bunnell. The mail ballot request deadline is **August 8, 2020**.



## ATTENTION VOTERS!

### Florida Statutes

101.62 (1)(b):

The supervisor may accept a written or telephonic request for a Vote-By-Mail ballot to be mailed to an elector's address on file in the Florida Voter Registration System from the elector, or, if directly instructed by the elector, a member of the elector's immediate family, or the elector's legal guardian; if the ballot is requested to be mailed to an address other than the elector's address on file in the Florida Voter Registration System, the request must be made in writing and signed by the elector. However, an absent uniformed service voter or an overseas voter seeking a Vote-By-Mail ballot is not required to submit a signed, written request for a Vote-By-Mail ballot that is being mailed to an address other than the elector's address on file in the Florida Voter Registration System.

A Vote-By-Mail ballot request to an address *other than* the elector's address on file, must be submitted in **WRITING** and **SIGNED** by the voter. Please complete and deliver or mail the form below to request a Vote-By-Mail ballot.
