





- We provide all police services for the City of Palm Coast, Town of Beverly Beach, Town of Marineland, as well as the unincorporated areas. We support Flagler Beach and Bunnell's Police Departments.
- We provide all court and detention services in Flagler County and our jail is the Sheriff Perry Hall Inmate Detention Facility (AKA: The Green Roof Inn) with a capacity of 404 inmates.
- We also operate the 911 center in Flagler County which answers and dispatches all 911 and non-emergency calls for police, fire, and medical services.
- There are more than 400 members of the Sheriff's Office serving you!


2021 Analytics ALOOK BACK





Flagler County Population and Crime Rate 2017-2021





Focus Crimes

ROBBERY

- Many incidents have involved juveniles often drugs are involved or social media arguments.
- Often, suspects and victims are known to each other.
- No significant correlation among cases (time of day, day of week, etc.).

RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

- Targeted items include bicycles, lawn equipment, and supplies from construction sites.
- FCSO has extra patrols in affected areas.
- Reminding public to lock doors and close garages.
- Keep your car doors locked too.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

- Each case is reviewed by a dedicated Domestic Violence detective.
- FCSO Victim Advocates
 walk the victim through
 the entire court process.
- GPS Monitoring is available for the judge to issue to the offender.
- The Domestic Violence
 Task Forces, established
 by Sheriff Staly in 2017,
 meets regularly to work
 to combat this issue.

LARCENY

- Targeted items include catalytic converters, bicycles, electronics, jewelry, and packages.
- Catalytic converters
 are commonly cut from
 vehicles overnight,
 especially in public or
 storage parking lots.
- Reminding public to close garages.
- Take packages inside after delivery.
- Record bicycle serial number in case of theft.






There were 17 traffic fatalities in 2021, down from 27 in 2020.



Operation D.R.I.V.E.

AVOID DISTRACTIONS WHILE DRIVING

The Flagler County Sheriff's Office, the Florida Highway Patrol, the Flagler Beach Police Department and the Bunnell Police Department are combining efforts to participate in Operation DRIVE.

Operation DRIVE is a countywide traffic education and enforcement operation focusing on Distracted & Reckless Intersection Violation Enforcement.

Operation DRIVE aims to reduce all crash types and aggressive/reckless driving. Flagler County experienced a decrease in fatal crashes and crashes with injuries in 2021 but the data revealed that no injury or non-life threatening injury crashes increased. The majority of these increased crashes occurred while entering, within, and while exiting intersections. This Operation is aimed at educating and enforcing traffic safety violations surrounding these locations.

Operations

OPERATION WINTER WONDER CELLS

A 14-month investigation lead to the arrest warrants of 24 drug dealers. After a sweep, FCSO's Operation "Winter Wonder Cells" resulted in 20 arrests.



More than \$277,000 in narcotics have been seized in the operation. Among the controlled substances seized in the operation are Fentanyl, Heroin, Oxycodone, Cocaine, THC Oil, Methamphetamine, and Cannabis.



Sheriff Staly joined his Special Investigations Unit (SIU) and the FCSO P.A.C.E. Unit to serve the felony arrest warrants. Some suspects of Operation Winter Wonder Cells had previously been arrested when search warrants were served at their poison peddling locations or were already in the Sheriff Perry Hall Inmate Detention Facility.



Autism Awareness



In honor of Autism Awareness Month, the FCSO will be launching a new Autism Awareness program to help those with Autism in Flagler County



About the Program

Does someone in your home have autism? If so, you may be interested in the Flagler County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) Autism Awareness. This is a program developed to help keep your loved one with autism safe. The program is based on Project Guardian developed by the Newport News (VA) Police Department.

The program is a free, voluntary, and confidential database offered, managed, and maintained by the FCSO for Flagler County residents.

How Do I Join the Program?

Go to FlaglerSheriff.com. At the top of the page there is a drop down menu called "Programs". Scroll down and select "Autism Awareness". You will be taken to a page with information on the program and an online application.

Deputies often do not know if individuals they encounter have autism. Information is key in helping deputies respond safely and effectively.
All deputies in the FCSO receive training on autism. Knowing the person has autism will help deputies utilize their training:

- •Turning off flashing emergency lights, if safe to
- •Remaining calm.
- ·Speaking in a calm tone of voice.
- ·Speaking simply and briefly.
- Moving slowly.
- Not touching the individual with autism, unless necessary for safety.
- •Being friendly, patient, accepting and encouraging.
- •Reassuring the person that no harm is
- Announcing actions before initiating them.
- Giving space; not crowding the person.
- ·Being patient.
- •Realizing the person with autism may have limited or no verbal skills.

- Attempting to learn what the person with autism is interested in and talking about it to help facilitate discussion.
- •Not taking a lack of eye contact as a sign of guilt.
- •Realizing that interacting with law enforcement can be very traumatizing for individuals with

Additional tools to keep your loved ones safe

SafeTrak: is a bracelet that when worn will identify and assist in the quick recovery of participants suffering from certain medical conditions or those with special needs.

K-9 scent kits: These are available free of charge and are used to enhance and increase the use of our scent discriminating bloodhound in searching for the missing or lost.

Stickers to be placed on your home or vehicle window are available for issuance to family members.






