

The Flagler Youth Orchestra strings program, a special project of the Flagler County School District and Friends of the Youth Orchestra, is a free after school program that teaches students how to play, violin, viola, cello and doublebass in an orchestral setting. Any student, third grade and up, who lives or receives their education in Flagler County is welcome to join. Classes are held on the Indian Trails Middle School campus during the school year. Students learn about the enriching world of classical music, as well as many other genres, while receiving string instruction in a player-friendly environment. All students participate in performance opportunities throughout the year. Instrument scholarships are provided to those in need. The Flagler Youth Orchestra is currently celebrating its seventeenth season.


The Flagler Youth Orchestra's mission is to provide free, quality instruction and performance opportunities in full orchestral and chamber music ensembles for Flagler County students at all skill levels. Our commitment to musical excellence and cultural diversity fosters a lifelong love of music while our performances enrich the musical life of our young community and reflect its growing commitment to the arts.

Joe Corporon, Artist Director of the FYO, is a graduate of the University of Miami in Coral Gables, FL, with a degree in cello performance. He is principal cellist, frequent soloist and a founding member of Daytona Solisti Chamber Orchestra and an active freelance musician in Central Florida. He is also a member of the Rickman-Acree-Corporon Piano Trio which performs annual concerts as part of the Daytona Solisti Concert Series. He is very excited to return to Flagler Youth Orchestra, where he previously taught from 2013-2019.

Mr. Corporon has served in the music ministries at United Methodist congregations in Ormond Beach, FL, Amarillo, TX, and Orlando, FL. He is a former member of the Miami Bach Society and taught for several years in private and public schools in Miami-Dade and Volusia counties.

Joe and his wife, Donna, are the proud parents of two girls and two boys. They also enjoy their three fur babies – two cats and a dog. In his spare time Joe enjoys arranging music for voices and instrumental ensembles, developing websites, and learning the intricacies of Manjaro Linux and other open source software.
