On {date} 08/03/2019, at {location} 119 Willow Oak Way, Palm Coast, FL 32137, Respondent:

We went to dinner and had a few drinks. An argument started. I do not recall what it was about. I was not feeling well when we got home. I went to the bathroom. Johnny came into the bathroom and grabbed me by the hair and pulled me into the master bedroom. He pushed me forcefully on the bed and jumped on my back while I was facedown in the bed. He started punching me in the back of the head. He then pushed my face down into a pillow. I could not breathe. I was screaming and he finally let me go. I tried to fight back but he was too strong. He turned me over and strangled me as hard as he could. I almost lost consciousness. He eventually let me go. I choked and gasped for air. I begged him to call the police. He got his phone and pretended to make a call to the police, but they never came. He left me laying in the bed and I tried not to move so he would stop hitting me and think I was asleep. I heard him go into the bathroom and returned to the bed. He grabbed my hair and held my head up. He proceeded to put pills in my mouth and then poured water down my throat. I still remained quiet with my eyes closed. As soon as I heard him leave to go to the bathroom, I spit them out on the bed. Finally, he came to bed. I quietly watched him fall asleep with the tv on. I tried to slip out of bed to get I and try to get help. I was walking to the master bedroom door when he came up behind me grabbing my arms saying "Where are you going?" I said I want to get my robe. He pulled me back to bed and laid me down. I pretended to go to sleep. I watched him fall asleep and again slipped out of bed. I walked across the living room and kitchen. As soon as I got to door I heard him come out of the bedroom. I went into I room and sat on her bed telling her to wake up and come with mommy, that we had to leave. He came into I room and told her to go back to sleep. He then began to push me out of the room. He pushed me as hard as he could to the ground. I followed us out of the bedroom, watching as he continued to violently abuse me. I realized that him pushing me to the ground had caused severe damage to my head. I began to scream. He grabbed me by the hair and proceeded to drag ,e across the kitchen, living room and into the bedroom. I followed us, asking John "why are you hurting mommy?" John shut the door in her face and locked it. I

continued to scream to get help because my daughter was outside the door. He then pushed me on the bed and covered my mouth and nose with his hands. I was unable to breathe and I felt like I may pass out. He turned me over again and continued to punch me in the head and back. At some point he turned me over and slapped me on the left side of my head. I tried to get up and get to the door, but every time he would grab me and throw me on the bed, beating me some more and yelling at me to shut up. The baby was screaming outside the door. I yelled for her to get out of the house and get help. I screamed and would not stop. I begged him to call the ambulance because I knew he had really hurt my head. He finally called, claiming that I had "meltdown" and had hurt myself that night. He told them that I have a lot of psychological issues and this was the reason I had hurt myself. I could hear the 911 operator on the phone and I screamed for her to come help me. I finally knew that someone was coming. I was standing at the front door when I saw the police lights and someone walking towards the door. I went to open the door and he pushed me aside. He ran outside and immediately began to tell the police that I was crazy and I had a psychotic episode that was caused by drinking alcohol. I crumbled to the floor, crying in fear of him taking I from me. He had always threatened to use my psychological issues against me to take **I** if I ever tried to leave him. He said he had all the paperwork and evidence from events that happened three years to get me committed to a psych ward and prove I was an unfit parent. Yes, three years ago I had a perfect storm of issues that required intensive care to work through. I have worked diligently to manage these issues through the years. I have been the primary caregiver for I for the last three years without incidence. My family helps me when needed beause of a stroke and heart attack, from three years ago, that caused short term memory loss. I has never been neglected or abused until John beat her mother in front of her. There have been several other incidents of strangling and beating on the back of my head where I have been afraid to call the authorities. Police report attached.
