Today 5/27/15, [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] and S [REDACTED] to have sex. [REDACTED] said, "Ok". S [REDACTED] followed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to the back of the classroom. [REDACTED] asked S [REDACTED] to pull his pants down so that he could see his private part. [REDACTED] told S [REDACTED] "I'm going to touch it" and touched his private. [REDACTED] gave S [REDACTED] private area a kiss. [REDACTED] said that he put his mouth on S [REDACTED] private area. [REDACTED] initiated the incident. The incident was reported to law enforcement. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have been suspended from school. They will not return for the remainder of the school year.

The children are in VPK.

III. Assessment Implications

A. Offense Characteristics

From most accounts, [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] and S [REDACTED] did they want to have sex. It was reported that [REDACTED] kissed S [REDACTED] penis but he denies that. He admits to grabbing his penis with his hand for about 5 seconds. [REDACTED] admits to touching S [REDACTED] penis because [REDACTED]



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told him to. S [redacted] stated that [redacted] touched his penis with his hands and [redacted] kissed his penis with his mouth. There were no secrets, bribes or coercion to get S [redacted] to comply. [redacted] offered to be [redacted] best friend if he touched S [redacted] penis.

B. Child Maltreatment History

There is no history of sexual victimization. [redacted] explains that [redacted] told him that he knew about sex from seeing it on TV. [redacted] denies this. There is no physical abuse or history of neglect with either child. There is no family or domestic violence with either child.

C. Social and Interpersonal Skill and Relationship

There is no history of instability. Each child has adequate social skills and peer relationships. There are no reports of social isolation.

D. Sexual Knowledge and Experience

[redacted] does not admit to any advanced knowledge of sexual practices. However, he has been cited for talking about sex previously. [redacted] lives in a home with no internet access and no cable television. His mother denied that there were any pornographic materials in the house. [redacted] does not have an advanced knowledge of sexual practices. He denied ever viewing pornography.

E. Academic and Cognitive Functioning

[redacted] and [redacted] have no academic difficulties. They have both maintained grade level knowledge and will graduate from VPK. However, due to the sexual incident, both children are ineligible to participate in graduation activities.

F. Mental Health Issues

[redacted] does not have any current or past mental health problems.
[redacted] does not have any current or past mental health problems.

IV. Treatment Needs

S [redacted] was offered counseling services. His mother declined those services. She wants to keep a state of normalcy and plans on having a busy summer and rest of the year in hopes that in time he will forget that this happened.

[redacted] was offered counseling services. His mother declined those services. She did say that she would be open to taking a business card and contacting someone if any other issues became apparent.

[redacted] was offered counseling services. His mother accepted services and gave [redacted] Medicaid number. She is concerned that he has too much sexual knowledge from an unknown source. She believed that he was too comfortable with not thinking about being caught. She wants to make sure that he knows the seriousness of his actions.

V. Services/Compliance Narrative

CPT took the case as an exception.
A referral was made to the house next door.
