she attempted to get away from him in fear.

On November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021, at approximately 1227 hours, members of the Bunnell Police Department (BPD) and Flagler County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) responded to 4600 E. Moody Blvd, Apt 5A in reference to a domestic disturbance.

Due to my previous encounters with the residents at this address and BPD and FCSO Deputies responding to this address multiple times in the past regarding civil and verbal disturbances, I was familiar that the subject involved were possible Amber L. Bruder and Jacob S. Baer, the father of her children, and her live-in boyfriend.

Upon arrival, Cpl. Groth and I attempted multiple times to knock on the front door and announced "Bunnell Police Department", but there was no answer. I then walked to the side of the apartment to knock on the sliding glass door and knocked again but no answer. While looking through the curtains, I was able to see a soda bottle on the floor along with other dark items. At that time, FCSO Deputy Wilkinson arrived on scene for back up.

I returned to the front door and noticed it was not secured and was starting to open freely when I continued to knock. At that time, FCSO Dispatch e-mailed the 911 call from Amber to Cpl. Groth. Both Cpl. Groth and I heard the e-mail in which it appeared that Amber was in distress when she asked for police to respond to her residence and then disconnected.

Due to the nature of the 911 recording, no answer inside the residence, and the front door being open, I feared Amber was in imminent danger and opened the front door to check on her wellbeing. Once the front door was opened, Cpl. Groth began to give multiple announcements for anyone inside to make themselves be known and advised the Bunnell Police Department was at the front door. Before Cpl. Groth and I made entry, I observed a broken glass picture frame on the ground near the front door and multiple other items near the living room that raised my suspicion that a physical struggle occurred.

FCSO Deputy Lichty arrived on scene shortly with a shield and made entry to the residence along with Cpl. Groth and me. While sweeping the residence, I noticed a broken bowl on the kitchen floor and kitchen countertop. There was multiple clothes and items scattered all over the main bedroom and bathroom, but no one was found inside.

Once the apartment was cleared, and due to there being an obvious sign of struggle, Cpl. Groth requested FCSO

Dispatch to ping Amber's cellphone. At that time, FCSO Deputy Wilkinson who left the scene and began searching the apartment complex for Amber and Jacob, advised he found both in front of building 15.

FCSO Deputy Ocampo who arrived on scene for backup stayed at the apartment while I responded to building 15. Upon arrival, I observed FCSO Deputy Wilkinson had already secured Jacob in his handcuffs, and Amber was sitting down on the sidewalk in front of building 15.

When I made contact with Amber, she stated that prior to calling 911, she and Jacob were having a verbal argument inside the bedroom over him wanting to use her cellphone to make some calls. When Amber refused to give Jacob her cellphone, he continued to reach for her phone and a physical struggle ensued. As Jacob attempted to grab Amber's cellphone, she swung her arms to try to get away from him and hit him in the eye by accident.

Amber stated she went to the bathroom to call 911 and then was able to walk towards the living room, and Jacob followed her but stopped in the kitchen. Both began to argue again, at which time Jacob picked up a bowl and smashed it on the floor, breaking it in the process. When he broke the bowl, Amber advised she got upset, which caused her to grab a glass portrait near the front door and smash it on the ground.


At that time, Jacob walked towards Amber who was still in the living room and grabbed her left forearm. Amber stated once Jacob grabbed her forearm, he directed her hand onto his throat and was trying to make her choke him. At that time, Amber stated she was able to push Jacob off her and she left the apartment through the front door due to her being in fear of him. Amber also advised during the struggle her phone dropped on the ground and she was not able to turn it on again.

Once Amber exited the apartment she began to walk towards the west entrance of the complex and was able to cross the street into 4601 E. Moody Blvd (Marvin's Garden).

Amber then stated Jacob grabbed her arm multiple times, pulling her back towards him while she was trying to get away, she also told him to stop and let her go multiple times. Amber continued to state that while Jacob pulled her arm, he told her that "He isn't going anywhere, and we need to get our story straight".

Once Amber noticed Jacob was continuing to follow her, she walked back to 4600 E. Moody Blvd and stopped in front of Apt 15. That is when she made contact with FCSO Deputy Wilkinson.

After speaking with Amber, I spoke with FCSO Deputy Wilkinson who advised Jacob was read his Miranda

warning and wished to speak to him and Cpl. Groth on what occurred.

While questioning the male post Miranda, he stated that he tripped on something in the kitchen, and hit a bowl and plate, which caused them to shatter. Jacob then stated that Amber broke the picture frame, that was located on the wall. He stated that she did this because she thought he broke the bowl on purpose.


He then stated Amber went to walk out of the residence, and he followed her outside to calm her down: When asked what caused the cut on his knuckle, and the bruising under his eyes, he stated that all those injuries were due to his construction work.

I returned to Amber who stated she had a bruise on her left bicep, but it was from yesterday where he pinched her. Amber refused medical attention.

Due to both statements from Jacob and Amber placing him with Amber during the time of the incident, Jacob grabbing her inside the apartment against Amber's will, Jacob pulling Amber back towards him as she was trying to leave him, causing her fear in the process, and attempting to get her to match his story prior to law enforcement arrival, Jacob was placed under arrest for domestic battery, tampering with a victim, and domestic false imprisonment.

Jacob was then for any narcotics or weapons which yielded in negative results and transported to the Flagler County inmate Facility (FCIF) without incident.

Amber was issued a Domestic Violence packet/Marcy's law form in which she initially stated she wanted to pursue the charges against Jacob, but later changed her mind and did not wish to. Pictures of both parties will be added to this report.
