The undersigned certifies and swears that there is probable cause to believe the above named defendant, on the <u>14th</u> day of <u>December</u> , <u>2017</u> , at approximately <u>7:34</u> <input type="checkbox"/> a.m. <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> p.m. at <u>320 Palm Coast Parkway NE, Palm Coast within Flagler County, violated the law and did then and there:</u> On Thursday, December 14th, 2017 at approximately 1936 hours, Deputy Darrell Butler responded to 320 Palm Coast Parkway NE (Shell fuel station) in Palm Coast, in reference to an armed robbery. Upon arrival, Dep. Butler made contact with Addie Elaine Cooper, the store clerk/victim. According to Cooper, an unknown black male entered the store, pointed a silver-colored firearm at her and demanded the money from the cash register. Cooper further advised that she placed the money (approximately \$200 USD in paper currency) in a plastic bag and gave it to the male. Per Cooper, the money consisted of a single \$100 bill, four \$20 bills and various smaller bills. Cooper stated that the male then demanded one pack of Newport 100's cigarettes valued at \$6.49 USD. Cooper advised that the male then fled the store on foot, southbound across Palm Coast Parkway NE. Cooper went on to state that the male threatened to shoot her during the course of the incident and threatened to return to the store and kill her if Law Enforcement was notified. Cooper advised she was not injured during the incident. Cooper then completed a written statement. Cooper described the suspect as a black male approximately 6'0" tall, weighing approximately 250 lbs., wearing a black "pulllover" sweatshirt, black pants, black "fingerless" gloves and a black ski-mask to conceal his face. Upon Dep. Butler's arrival at the Shell station, he was granted access to the available security footage. The security footage showed a black male with a large build, approximately 6'0" tall, with a black beard and mustache, wearing a black "pulllover" sweatshirt, black pants, and black and white Nike running shoes with white "Swoosh" and white soles approach the front of the store, pull a black "ski mask" over his face and enter the store.

The male was seen drawing a silver-colored, long-barrel revolver with his right hand, which he then pointed at Cooper. Cooper is then observed placing U.S. paper currency from the cash register into a plastic bag, which she then hands to the male. The male is then observed gesturing towards the cigarettes with the firearm, and after being given one pack of cigarettes, the male is observed exiting the store on foot in a southeastern direction through the parking lot. Several Flagler County Sheriff's Office members searched the area for the suspect. A perimeter was established but the search was met with negative results.

Detective Robert Blanton then responded to the scene to interview Cooper. At approximately 2030 hours, Sergeant Bernard Woodward contacted Detective Agustin Rodriguez to inform him of the armed robbery at the Shell station.

Det. Rodriguez had recently reviewed footage from a suspicious incident that occurred at the Mobil station located at 295 Pine Lakes Parkway in Palm Coast on December 12th, 2017 (See FCSO Case # 17-108798). During that incident, a black, heavyset male standing approximately 6'0" tall, wearing all black, including a ski-mask, rushed up to the front door of the business and pulled on the door handle. The male appeared to be holding his waistband area, consistent with someone concealing a firearm.

Once the subject realized that the business was closed for the evening, he ran off towards Wynnfield Drive.

After reviewing the footage, Det. Rodriguez believed he could identify that subject as Charles Eugene Rushing-Griffen (B/M - 9/12/90).

Det. Rodriguez previously encountered Rushing-Griffen during the course of a search warrant (See FCSO Case # 17-85986) that was executed on October 2nd, 2017 at 6B Ryall Lane in Palm Coast. Rushing-Griffen was not arrested that day, but he was interviewed at length.

At approximately 2051 hours, Chief Paul Bovino sent a surveillance photo of the suspect from the armed robbery at the Shell station to Det. Rodriguez. The picture showed a black, heavyset male standing approximately 6'0" tall, wearing all black, with a black ski-mask. This time, the ski-mask was resting atop his head, not covering his face, making him easily identifiable. Det. Rodriguez was then able to positively identify the suspect as Rushing-Griffen.

Stationary surveillance was then established at Rushing-Griffen's last known address, 6B Ryall Lane in Palm Coast. In the driveway of 6B Ryall Lane, a blue Ford Crown Victoria bearing Florida tag Y99ZFD was observed.

A male subject could be seen sitting in the driver's seat but due to poor lighting conditions, the male could not be identified at that time.

Several minutes later, two subjects were seen exiting the residence and entering the vehicle. The two subjects were known to Det. Rodriguez to be Dhaighanyoosuf Tariq Khawaja (O/M - 10/23/89) and Camerac Lateice Hubbert (B/F - 11/1/91). Khawaja entered the vehicle from the front passenger door while Hubbert entered through the rear driver's side passenger door.

Seconds later, the driver exited the vehicle and walked into the residence. At that time, Det. Rodriguez positively identified the driver as Rushing-Griffen.

Rushing-Griffen returned to the vehicle moments later, then pulled out of the driveway. Detectives began following the vehicle until marked patrol units could safely affect a traffic stop.

Detectives followed the vehicle to the 1200 block of US Highway 1 where a "High Risk Traffic Stop" was affected by multiple members of the Flagler County Sheriff's Office.

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Rushing-Griffen, Khawaja and Hubbert were then safely taken into custody.  
Rushing-Griffen was found to be in possession of \$270.00 U.S. Currency and a red bandana. Photographs were taken of Rushing-Griffen's property. They will later be uploaded to Aegis.

The vehicle was then cleared of any other occupants or dangers. During said clearing, Commander Steve Brandt observed the butt of a silver revolver resting under the driver's seat, where Rushing-Griffen was sitting. The vehicle was then sealed with evidence tape and transported to the Flagler County Sheriff's Office's Operations Center's Evidence Garage. A search warrant for the vehicles passenger compartment was later obtained and will be executed in a timely manner.

All three subjects were then transported to the Flagler County Sheriff's Office's Operations Center located at 901 East Moody Boulevard in Bunnell.

There, all three subjects were separated and interviewed.

Khawaja was read his Miranda warnings, to which he advised that he understood.  
Khawaja was questioned about his whereabouts at approximately 1930 hours. Khawaja advised that he was home with his girlfriend, Hubbert. Khawaja was then asked about the whereabouts of Rushing-Griffen around that same time.

Khawaja advised that Rushing-Griffen left the house to drop Hubbert's kids at her residence in Bunnell, but he could not advise a specific time. Khawaja was then showed the surveillance photo from the Shell station robbery. Khawaja advised that he could not identify the subject in the photo.

Hubbert was then read her Miranda warnings, to which she advised that she understood.

Hubbert was asked the same line of questioning and gave similar responses regarding Rushing-Griffen's whereabouts during the time of the robbery.

Hubbert was however, able to identify the subject in the surveillance photo. Hubbert identified the subject as Rushing-Griffen.

Detectives then read Rushing-Griffen his Miranda warnings, to which he advised that he understood.

Rushing-Griffen began the interview by stating that he was home all day. Detectives advised Rushing-Griffen that there was substantial evidence proving that was false and that he was suspected of committing an armed robbery.

It was also learned that Rushing-Griffen is a four-time convicted felon. Based on the admissions of Rushing-Griffen, he will also be charged with possession of a firearm by a convicted felon.

Due to Rushing-Griffen's license being suspended, he was also charged with driving while license suspended with knowledge.

Rushing-Griffen was later transported to the Flagler County Sheriff's Office's Inmate Facility without incident. There is nothing further to report.
