

The undersigned certifies and swears that there is probable cause to believe the above named defendant, on the <u>26th</u> day of <u>July</u> , <u>2018</u> , at approximately <u>3:06</u> <input type="checkbox"/> a.m. <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> p.m. at <u>1475 Palm Coast Parkway NW, ste 102, Palm Coast</u> within <u>Flagler</u> County, violated the law and did then and there: The following is in reference to the service of a search warrant at 1475 Palm Coast Parkway NW, Suite 102 in Palm Coast, FL, and the subsequent arrest of the defendant, Jerard Keaton Davis. On the 25th of July, 2018, Detective Rodriguez applied for, and was granted, two search warrant for the business located at 1475 Palm Coast Parkway NW, Suite 102 in Palm Coast, FL and the 2003 gold Dodge Ram 1500 pick-up truck registered to Davis. The search warrants were granted by the Honorable Judge Terrance Perkins. The search warrants were executed by the Flagler County Sheriff's Office's Special Investigations Unit with the assistance of the Flagler County Sheriff's Office's SWAT team on the 26th day of July, 2018. The defendant was detained while Detective Rodriguez read the search warrant for the business and the defendant's Miranda Warnings aloud. The defendant advised that he understood his Miranda Warnings. During the course of the search, the defendant was found to be in the possession of the following:

- Approximately 0.12 grams of a white rock-like substance (Found on shelf of desk in back office inside an ash tray)
- A loaded Smith & Wesson Bodyguard .380 handgun (S/N – EBZ1846) (Found on shelf of desk in back office)
- A small digital scale (Found on shelf of desk in back office)
- Approximately 3.25 grams of Cannabis inside a black plastic bag labeled “Cookies” (Found on shelf of desk in back office)
- Three (3) loose plastic Ziploc style baggies (Found on shelf of desk in back office)
- Approximately 2.26 grams of Cannabis inside a plastic baggie (Found inside the defendant’s pants pocket)
- A rolled Cannabis cigar (Found inside the defendant’s pants pocket)
- Ziploc style baggie containing multiple smaller empty baggies (Found within the defendant’s truck)

The above mentioned white rock-like substances all independently tested presumptive positive for the presence of Cocaine after Detective Rodriguez tested the substances using Lynn Peavey Cocaine Quick Check Field Test Kits which are standard Law Enforcement test kits.

Post Miranda, the defendant advised that the Crack Cocaine was his, but it was for his personal use. Based on the quantity, the packaging, the digital scale, the amount of empty baggies and the previous knowledge of Detective Rodriguez that the defendant actively sells Crack Cocaine, there is sufficient probable cause to believe the defendant was in possession of Crack Cocaine with the intent to sell.

Also, the location where the Crack Cocaine was found was within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising the Sunshine Academy child care facility (1230 Palm Coast Parkway NW). Sunshine Academy is a free-standing private child development center and preschool (License # C07FL0036). It has a licensed capacity of 208 students and operates year round. There is a large free-standing sign reading “Sunshine Academy” that faces Palm Coast Parkway and is legible from a great distance.


Post Miranda, the defendant admitted to the possession of all the recovered Cannabis.

Post Miranda, the defendant advised that he knew the firearm was in the business and that it is there on the desk “Every day.” The defendant was confronted with video evidence of him brandishing a similar looking firearm on a Facebook Live video on July 16th, 2018. The defendant hesitated and advised that the firearm in the video was a BB gun that looks exactly like the gun in question. The defendant also stated that he frequently moves the gun “out of the way” but doesn’t carry it because he is a convicted felon.

It should be noted that the defendant was already charged and arrested for Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon and Violation of an Injunction for Protection Against Domestic Violence on July 26th, 2018, stemming from an arrest warrant issued on July 25th, 2018 (See FCSO Case #18-69065).

The defendant was placed under arrest and later transported to the Flagler County Inmate Facility without incident by Deputy Alicia Cowan.
