9/17/18@ 8:31 p.m./ Assist other agency/ 2018-21466/ 400 Block South Oceanshore Boulevard: Officers were requested to assist the Flagler County Sheriff Office, in locating a suicidal juvenile female. An approximate pinged location was given, but later a more specific location (400 S. Oceanshore Blvd) was relayed to Flagler Dispatch by a friend of the female. The female was located and placed in protective custody by FCSO. (FCSO Case #18-88213).

9/17/18 @9:34 p.m./ Suspicious Incident/2018-21467/400 Block South Oceanshore Boulevard: While transferring custody of the aforementioned Baker-Act, Officers were waved down by a passer-by who stated a male was on the ground next to a green Kia Soul across the street. Upon arrival Officers observed substantial damage to the Kia Soul, a male sleeping on the ground, and a female bound with duct tape partially naked in the vehicle. The Flagler County Sheriff Office advised that they have dealt with the same subjects earlier in the shift, for the same purpose and determined no criminal activity. It was determined through our investigation that both subjects were engaged in a consensual role playing scenario. Damage was observed to their vehicle; however, no reports of a hit and run were reported. FCSO conducted a check of the area they were last seen with negative results for any damaged property. Neither subject was observed to be in actual control of the vehicle, due to their intoxication a family friend was requested to pick them up. R/O advised she would have the vehicle towed in the morning.
