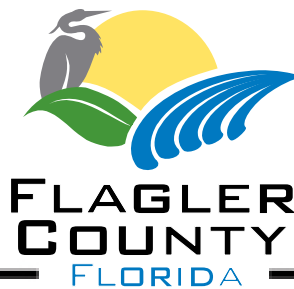

**Re: Public Records Request**

Dear Public Records Officer:

Pursuant to Article I, Section 24(a), Florida Constitution, and Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners for Flagler County, Florida ("Flagler County") hereby makes the following request for records.

This request is for public records in the possession of the Florida Department of Financial Services, the Florida Chief Financial Officer, the Florida Agency for Fiscal Oversight, and/or the Office of the Governor, (collectively referenced hereinafter as the "Agencies") which includes its employees, agents, representatives, and any individual or entity acting on behalf of the Agencies, regardless of the location of those records.

This written request for records also serves to fulfill any notice requirements set forth in Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, including but not limited to, Section 119.12(1)(b), Florida Statutes. This written request satisfies the five-day notice provision contained in Section 119.12(1)(b), Florida Statutes. Flagler County will not provide any additional notice of your statutory obligation to timely furnish responsive records.

Requested Records

Flagler County requests that your office promptly produce the following:

- A copy of the final "Florida Agency for Fiscal Oversight" audit report relating to the "Flagler County Budget" as such term was referenced by Blaise Ingoglia on March 26, 2026, at his press event of the same date in Palm Coast, Florida.
- Any and all records sent, received, or reviewed by Blaise Ingoglia, Florida Chief Financial Officer ("CFO"), regarding the Florida Agency for Fiscal Oversight ("FAFO") review of the "Flagler County Budget" as such term was referenced by Blaise Ingoglia on March 26, 2026, at his press event of the same date in Palm Coast, Florida.

- Any and all records, reports, memoranda, documents, treatises, or other documentation either physical or electronic (including but not limited to financial ledgers, financial statements, receipts, audit reports, and other financial documents) illustrating the results and conclusions of the FAFO review of the “Flagler County Budget” as such term was referenced by Blaise Ingoglia on March 26, 2026, at his press event of the same date in Palm Coast, Florida.
- All email communications (including emails, calendar invitations, and attachments thereto) between (a) any of the Florida Department of Financial Services (“FDFS”) officials, including but not limited to the Chief Financial Officer or anyone communicating on his behalf (such as an assistant or scheduler), Chief of Staff, Director of External Affairs, General Counsel; (b) any representatives or officials of the Florida Agency for Fiscal Oversight (“FAFO”); or (c) any of the Office of the Governor officials, including but not limited to the Governor or anyone communicating on his behalf (such as an assistant or scheduler), Chief of Staff, Director of External Affairs, General Counsel, or Office of Policy and Budget Director, relating to the review of the “Flagler County Budget” as such term was referenced by Blaise Ingoglia on March 26, 2026, at his press event of the same date in Palm Coast, Florida by FDFS, CFO, FAFO, or the Office of the Governor.
- Any and all records, documents, and data reviewed by FDFS, the CFO, FAFO, and the Office of the Governor used to support the findings of the CFO in declaring the “Flagler County Budget as ‘excessive, wasteful spending’ as such term was referenced by Blaise Ingoglia on March 26, 2026, at his press event of the same date in Palm Coast, Florida.
- The phone log for any telecommunications device used by Blaise Ingoglia to send or receive calls during the period of between 12:00 a.m., July 16, 2025, and 11:59 p.m., March 26, 2026. “Phone log” means the record of calls made or received via any cellular or electronic device or messaging app.
- The text log of any cellular device used by Blaise Ingoglia to send or receive texts during the period between 12:00 a.m., July 16, 2025, through 11:59 p.m., March 26, 2026. “Text log” means the record of any texts sent or received via any cellular or electronic device or messaging app.
- Any and all records, sent and received either by mail or electronically by FDFS, the CFO, FAFO, or the Office of the Governor relating to the public event held at the Club at Hammock Beach, Palm Coast, Florida on March 26, 2026.
- Any and all records, sent and received by FDFS, the CFO, FAFO, or the Office of the Governor to/from the Flagler County Republican Executive Committee relating to the conclusions of the FDFS, CFO, FAFO or Office of the Governor raised by Blaise Ingoglia on March 26, 2026, relating to the “Flagler County Budget” as such term was referenced by Blaise Ingoglia on March 26, 2026, at his press event of the same date in Palm Coast, Florida.
- Any and all records, sent, received, or reviewed by FDFS, the CFO, FAFO, or the Office of the Governor to/from the Flagler County Democratic Party relating to the conclusions of the FDFS, CFO, FAFO or Office of the Governor raised by Blaise Ingoglia on March 26, 2026, relating to the “Flagler County Budget” as such term was referenced by Blaise Ingoglia on March 26, 2026, at his press event of the same date in Palm Coast, Florida.

- Any and all records, documents, and data relating to the methodology used by the FDFS, CFO, FAFO, or the Office of the Governor to review the “Flagler County Budget” to support the conclusions raised by Blaise Ingoglia on March 26, 2026, relating to the “Flagler County Budget” as such term was referenced by Blaise Ingoglia on March 26, 2026, at his press event of the same date in Palm Coast, Florida.

Please provide all responsive records from July 16, 2025, through March 26, 2026.

Please notify Flagler County of any anticipated fees or costs in excess of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars prior to incurring such costs or fee.

Please note that Flagler County does not seek, and that this request specifically excludes the initial mailing of news clips or other mass-distribution emails. However, subsequent communications forwarding such emails are responsive to this request.

In the event some portions of the requested records are properly exempt from disclosure, please disclose any reasonably segregable non-exempt portions of the requested records. If it is your position that a document contains non-exempt segments, but that those non-exempt segments are so dispersed throughout the document as to make segregation impossible, please state what portion of the document is non-exempt, and how the material is dispersed throughout the document. If a request is denied as a whole, please state specifically that it is not reasonable to segregate portions of the record for release.

To ensure that this request is properly construed, that searches are conducted in an adequate but efficient manner, and that extraneous costs are not incurred, the Office of the County Attorney, on behalf of Flagler County, welcomes an opportunity to discuss its request with the respective Agencies before they undertake their research or incur search or duplication costs. By working together at the outset, Flagler County and the respective Agencies can decrease the likelihood of costly and time-consuming litigation in the future.

Where possible, please provide responsive material in electronic format by email or in .pdf or .tif format on a USB drive. Please send any responsive material being sent by mail to Flagler County, c/o Office of the County Attorney, 1769 East Moody Boulevard, Building No. 2, Bunnell, Florida 32110. If it will accelerate release of responsive records to Flagler County, please also provide responsive material on a rolling basis.

Flagler County looks forward to working with the respective Agencies on this request.
