**Protocols for controlling COVID-19** 

A parent or guardian allows the student to return, as long as the student continues to show no symptoms

If you are exposed\* to a positive COVID-19 case (close contact)

Have no symptoms

Have symptoms

You can return after

OR

You quarantine for up to seven days from the date of last direct contact with a person that is positive for COVID-19

You have quarantined for 10 days and have no symptoms or fever for 24 hours (without medication)

OR

You have received written permission from a healthcare provider to return

OR

You have a negative diagnostic COVID-19 test and show no symptoms

If you have symptoms or are COVID-19 positive

If you have had a
COVID-19 infection within
the past 90 days or are
fully vaccinated

You have symptoms

You can return after

You have no symptoms

No action required

\*Per CDC, exposure is close contact of 6 feet or less for 15 minutes or more.

Contact at greater than 6 feet or for less than 15 minutes generally is not sufficient to transmit the virus.
