## COVID-19 SYMPTOMATIC DECISION TREE



### Protocols for controlling COVID-19

1

If you are exposed\* to a positive COVID-19 case (close contact)

- Have no symptoms
- Have symptoms

You can return after

A parent or guardian allows the student to return, as long as the student continues to show no symptoms

OR

You quarantine for up to seven days from the date of last direct contact with a person that is positive for COVID-19

2

If you have symptoms or are COVID-19 positive

You can return after

You have quarantined for 10 days and have no symptoms or fever for 24 hours (without medication)

OR

You have received written permission from a healthcare provider to return

OR

You have a negative diagnostic COVID-19 test and show no symptoms

3

If you have had a COVID-19 infection within the past 90 days or are fully vaccinated

- You have symptoms
- You have no symptoms

No action required

\*Per CDC, exposure is close contact of 6 feet or less for 15 minutes or more. Contact at greater than 6 feet or for less than 15 minutes generally is not sufficient to transmit the virus.
