80517-18	Burglary Vehicle	Colorado	Two vehicles entered between 7:00pm on 8-25 and 7:30am today. Vehicles were rummaged through and a silver in color Kimber Crimson Pro II .45 caliber semi-automatic handgun, with a wooden handle and a laser attached was taken from one of the vehicles.
80369-18	Larceny Shoplifter (Follow Up)	Belle Terre Pkwy (Publix)	Deputy Lewis located the suspect vehicle on US1 near Belle Terre Blvd and conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. The driver was identified and after investigation it was determined that she was fully aware and involved in the theft. (charges for petit theft on S1 will be forwarded to SAO).
80618-18	Disturbance Domestic	Pheasant Drive	Units responded to 911 hang up and could hear verbal argument upon arrival. Investigation revealed S1 was in a verbal argument with his girlfriend when the argument escalated and he threw a cell phone at her attempting to strike her with it but missed her. S1 was arrested for domestic assault and transported to the inmate facility without incident.
