2018-82641	Burglary Residential/	Sugar Mill Lane South/	S1 and S2 stated that sometime between 7:45pm and 10:15pm an unknown person forced open the outside double doors that lead to their master bedroom and stole a black leather jewelry box containing approximately \$5000.00 in jewelry. The scene was processed for fingerprints and DNA. A black in color leather glove was collected from the front yard and will be processed for touch DNA. A neighborhood canvass was not conducted due to the time of night. Dayshift will be requested to conduct a canvass during daytime hours. There is no video surveillance available from the scene.
2018-82593	Fraud	5200 SR 100	S1 Attempted to make a purchase at Game Stop using 2 counterfeit \$100 bills, but the clerk realized they were fake. He then went to Target and did make a purchase with the 2 bills. He was stopped in the parking lot and it was discovered he had a warrant from St Johns for uttering forged bills. He was also charged locally.
2018-82650	Overdose	Royal Tern	Female was discovered in her bedroom unresponsive and not breathing. CPR was started by family. Deputies administered 2 doses of Narcan. Once Fire Rescue was on scene they did get a weak pulse, but she wasn't breathing on her own. ISD responded and took over the investigation.
2018-82589	Disturbance-Domestic	Ziegler Pl	S1 called 911 because her son S3 and her boyfriend S2 were in a verbal disturbance. Upon arrival S3 advised that he and S2 were in a verbal disturbance because they want him to move out. When contact was made with S2, he advised that S3 attempted to head-butt him, and lightly brushed his head across his nose. There were no injuries or visible marks on his nose. S3 was taken to a friend's house so there was no chance for further arguing. S2 would be leaving for a vacation in the morning and S3 would return when he leaves.
2018-82582	Warrant Service/	Boice Lane (Ormond)/	While responding to a civil complaint, Deputy Oldham and Deputy Beausoleil made contact with S1, who had an order to take into custody and transport to DJJ. Once in custody S1 stated that he wanted to kill himself and therefore a Baker Act form was completed. S1 was transported to DJJ and then taken to Halifax to due to the Baker Act. A zone Deputy stood by at Halifax all shift waiting for medical clearance.
