<p>DUI Battery on LEO/ 4214-18/ Circle K 1500 Palm Coast Pkwy SW/ Sector 215/ S1 was arrested for DUI. As he was being escorted to the patrol car he tried to pull away from the arresting officer's grip, causing both to fall to the ground. Once on the ground S1 began to violently resist arrest. S1 kicked Deputy Barkoskie and Deputy St. John intentionally and repeatedly in their lower legs as they tried to get him into the patrol car. Neither deputy sustained physical injury. S1 was transported to the FPDF without further incident.</p> <p>Disturbance Domestic/ 4245-18/ Seattle Trail/ Sector 224/ S1 was arrested for battery (dating violence) after he pushed his girlfriend down in the roadway causing abrasions and cuts on her knees and torso.</p>
