Larceny / 2017-00110298 / Birchwood Dr. / Sector 214 / V1 advised she had found jewelry in her daughter's room that belonged to her. S1 was located at her boyfriend's residence and was transported back to the residence at the request of V1. S1 and V1 remained at the residence, as well as multiple family members and friends. Grand theft criminal charges will be filed against S1 in reference to the stolen jewelry.

Animal Bite / 2017-00110313 / Big Dipper Ln. / Sector 214 / Neighbors called in to advise a female, V1, had been attacked by her dog and was trapped in her backyard. The neighbors were unable to access the backyard due to the dog being extremely aggressive. Deputy arrived on scene, entered the backyard to rescue V1, and was charged by the dog. Deputy deployed his agency issued chemical spray toward the dog, which subsequently retreated. Deputy S. Bell then escorted V1 out of the backyard to receive the necessary EMS treatment.

**Narcotics/2017-110207/ Regent Lane/Sector 222**

Deputy conducted a traffic stop on a pickup truck. The tag came back registered to a different vehicle. After initiating the stop the deputy discovered the driver, S1 had a suspended license. Suboxone and drug paraphernalia were located inside the vehicle .

**Domestic Disturbance/2017-110205/Secretary Trail/Sector 224**

RP stated S1 has been using "Molly". He grabbed her jacket and shoved her to the ground. S1 was located hiding in a bedroom closet. While securing the male he stated that he had "weed" in his pocked. S1 was arrested and transported to FCIF without incident reference to possession of cannabis.

RP advised that she was at her residence and her ex-boyfriend, S1, went "crazy" throwing the laundry basket around the house. There were no signs of any physical injury to RP and no marks on her face whatsoever. S1 denied anything physical occurring, and due to lack of physical evidence and conflicting stories no arrest was made at that time.

**Trespassing/2017-110330/ Richland Lane/Sector 222**

S1 came back to this residence despite him not living there and being told by deputies not to return to the residence. The resident then returned home and provided a key to law enforcement to enter the home and remove S1. S1 attempted to physically resist Deputies efforts to secure him and he was taken to the ground. He was then secured and transported to the inmate facility.
