Grand theft criminal charges will be filed against S1 in reference to the stolen jewelry.

The neighbors were unable to access the backyard due to the dog being extremely aggressive. Deputy arrived on scene, entered the backyard to rescue V1, and was charged by the dog. Deputy deployed his agency issued chemical spray toward the dog, which subsequently retreated. Deputy S. Bell then escorted V1 out of the backyard to receive the necessary EMS treatment.

S1 came back to this residence despite him not living there and being told by deputies not to return to the residence. The resident then returned home and provided a key to law enforcement to enter the home and remove S1. S1 attempted to physically resist Deputies efforts to secure him and he was taken to the ground. He was then secured and transported to the inmate facility.
