The caller advised he was a "hermit" but they would see him drive by on occasion, or put his garbage out. Deputies had to walk approximately a mile from the road to the residence, because trees and brush were covering the driveway, probably from the storm. Once at the home, forced entry was made through the front door, they then found the male deceased. Det. Conrad and the Medical Examiner responded to the scene.
