Part One UCR Crimes: Type of Call / Case Number / Address / Case Summary

Non-Part One Crimes: Missing Persons, Traffic Fatality, Use of Force, Weapons

Disturbance Verbal/ 17-8963/ E. Moody Blvd., Bunnell/ Dep. Gonzalez investigated verbal disturbance outside the Bunnell Kangaroo. Subject 1 (S1) George Wood 8-21-85, ignored commands, dove into his vehicle through a window and then tried to flee. The vehicle struck a pole, then S1 tried to strike Bunnell Police Officer FLynn with the vehicle. Officer Flynn Tased S1 and Wood was taken into custody. A loaded firearm was found in the vehicle. While deputies investigated, S1 broke the cage off the window to Dep. Gonzalez's vehicle and escaped. A perimeter was established, K9 was called out and VCSO's Air One responded. S1 was taken back into custody after jumping from a tree. S1 charged by Bunnell with an out-of-state warrant and aggravated assault on a law enforcement officer. Dep. Gonzalez charged S1 with Poss of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon. Reports by all involved parties. Also Police Vehicle Damage Report completed.

Disturbance Domestic/ 17-8959/ Colony Court, Palm Coast. / Deputies called to a disturbance between a father and stepson. Some pushing was reported; parties did not wish to cooperate and a primary aggressor could not be determined. Parties separated. Report by Dep. Lichty.

Crash W/ Injuries / 17-8969 / U.S. 1 South. Single-vehicle crash w/ejection Trauma alert. Turned over to the Florida Highway Patrol.

Domestic Disturbance/ 17-8964 / Zircon Court, Palm Coast. /Two men each called 911; parties were separated for the evening. A primary aggressor could not be determined. Report by D/S Myers.
