Narcotics/ 16-118638/ E. S.R. 100 (Burger King), Palm Coast. A man was located unresponsive in the men's restroom. He was revived by EMS and transported to FHF for treatment. Charges are being forwarded for possession of drug paraphernalia. Report by Deputy Lichty.

Disturbance Domestic/ 16-118727/ Bickford Drive, Palm Coast. Units originally responded to a panic alarm. Upon arrival, contact was made with Victim 1 (V1). V1 has several medical issues and advised he filled two presciptions today for controlled susbtances. He fell asleep and found a large amount of his medication had been stolen. He suspected his son, Subject 1 (S1) (Michael Chechilo w/m 12-24-92) and confronted him. S1 then grabbed V1, pushed him to the ground and broke his phone when he threatened to call law enforcement. S1 was arrested for Battery DV and Tampering with a Witness. Report by Dep. Grant Taylor.

Overdose/ 16-118745/ Pheasant Lane, Palm Coast. Other 1 (O1) took 3, 30mg Oxycodone tablets and was treated for an overdose. This was an apparent accidental overdose and not an attempt to harm herself. O1 was transported to FHF via Rescue 21 for further treatment. Report by Deputy Cavas.
