Missing Juvenile / 17-15400/ A child was reporting missing after the mother came to DCF office in Bunnell on 2/21/17, then left with the child when a drug test was requested of the mom. He texted his girlfriend, threatening to harm her and telling her he was waiting for her in their home. Perimeter established and contact attempted via phone and PA announcements; no response from Anthony. SWAT mini team was deployed. Anthony was located in the attic and was taken into custody.
