Part One UCR Crimes: Type of Call / Case Number / Address / Case Summary

Domestic Disturbance (Physical)/ 2017-30821/ Mahogany Boulevard, Bunnell/ Zone 7 / V1 stated that her boyfriend, Subject 1 (S1) Charles R. Higgins, took her to his house and held her against her will for approximately 17 hours. V1 stated that S1 struck her multiple times and slammed her head against a door. V1 stated she attempted to leave numerous times but was unable to get away and S1 broke her phone as she tried to call for help. V1 also stated that S1 held a knife to her neck while threatening to cut her throat. V1 eventually fled the residence where she found a neighbor who called 9-1-1. S1 was located at his residence and taken into custody without incident. S1 was charged with False Imprisonment, Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, Tampering with a Witness, Violation of No Contact Order, Domestic Battery, and Criminal Mischief.
