Part One UCR Crimes: Type of Call / Case Number / Address / Case Summary

17-34523/ Burglary residential/ Sleepy Hollow Trl, Palm Coast/Victim 1 (V1) reported seeing a male standing on her enclosed lanai. The male then ran and jumped over her 6' privacy fence. Nothing was stolen. No signs of forced entry were observed. Report by Dep. Myers.

Non-Part One Crimes: Missing Persons, Traffic Fatality, Use of Force, Weapons

17-34427/ Crash- Severe/ Royal Palms Pkwy @ Rymfire Dr/Head on collision, vehicle vs. school bus. Driver of vehicle transported as trauma alert to Halifax. Two juvenile occupants of that vehicle transported to FHF with apparent minor injuries. Bus driver transported to FHF. Single student occupant of bus was uninjured. Parent declined medical treatment. Intersection temporarily closed while crash scene was cleared. School board and bus garage notified and responded to the scene. Crash worked by FCSO Motor Unit; Report by Deputy Vedder.

17-34429/ Baker Act/ Paul Ln, Palm Coast/Subject was not taking medication and threatened suicide. Upon LEO arrival, she ran into the house. Perimeter established around the home. After a brief standoff, she was successfully talked out of the house and taken into custody without incident. She was then placed under Baker Act and transported to Halifax without incident. 17-34455 and 17-34505/ Welfare check-Disturbance Domestic/ Whippoorwill Dr, Palm Coast/ Subject left messages making statements to coworkers that he was going to harm himself or his girlfriend. Subject was seen in the house but refused to come speak with law enforcement. Girlfriend was present at her residence and reported she was fine. She then reported a delayed Disturbance Domestic. Units were never able to contact the subject. Follow up on nightshift. Reports by Dep Meehan, Dep Myers, and Cpl Miller.
