### Part One UCR Crimes: Type of Call / Case Number / Address / Case Summary

Disturbance-Domestic/40827-17/Fallwood Lane, Palm Coast /Zone 2/ An altercation occurred between a boyfriend and girlfriend. Male left the residence prior to deputies' arrival. No injuries reported; report made.

Disturbance-Domestic /40776-17/Florida Park Drive, Palm Coast /Zone 2/ Delayed reporting from overnight. Victim 1 (V-1) reported that she was in an altercation with her husband, Defendant 1 (D-1) Raymond Amara the previous day. During the altercation, V-1 stated that D-1 began pushing her, then retrieved a firearm and pushed the barrel of the gun against her head, hard enough to leave a mark (still visible) and push her down. V-1 stated that D-1 also put the gun in her mouth and threatened to kill her. V-1 stated she was afraid to leave overnight and finally went to her friend's house this morning when D-1 left for work. Contact was made with D-1 at his residence where he was questioned and taken into custody with the firearm matching the description (provided by V-1) found on his person. D-1 was charged with Battery (Domestic), Domestic Battery by Strangulation, and Aggravated Battery With Deadly Weapon (Domestic). D-1 was taken to FHF for medical issues then booked at the Flagler County detention facility without incident.

Burglary-Vehicle (Delayed)/403690-17/ N. Oceanshore Boulevard, Palm Coast / Zone 1/ V-1 reported a firearm missing from his vehicle glove box. V-1 last saw the firearm in his vehicle on 5/7/17 and he realized it was missing on 5/12/17. No signs of forced entry to his vehicle.
