Part One UCR Crimes: Type of Call / Case Number / Address / Case Summary

Assault/Battery/ 17-44606/ Knox Jones Avenue, Palm Coast / Subject 1 (S1) b/m 10-12-80, threw a brick at Victim 1 (V1)'s vehicle while she and her children were seated inside the vehicle. The brick damaged the windshield of the vehicle and caused a minor injury to V1. S1 fled into the wood-line upon seeing deputies. Perimeter established. Fireflight launched. Canine track initiated but subject was not located. Charges forwarded to the State Attorney's Office for Agg Assault, Throwing a Deadly Missile, Culpible Negligence, and Criminal Mischief. S1 also has several open warrants. Report by Dep. Crosbee.

Non-Part One Crimes: Missing Persons, Traffic Fatality, Use of Force, Weapons

17-44644 / Disorderly Conduct / Oceanshore Blvd. / A white male, Kalani Keoho 05-25-92 was arrested for disorderly conduct in campground. S1 caused a disturbance with other subjects in area and continued being disorderly while law enforcement was on scene. Arrested without further incident and trespassed from campground. Deputy Wall.

17-44734/ Disorderly Conduct / Kings Way, Palm Coast / S1 Latoya Lomax got into an argument with staff at Denny's and refused to leave. When law enforcement arrived, she provided a false name to law enforcement. Latoya was subsequently arrested for disorderly conduct and resisting law enforcement without violence. She was also trespassed from Denny's. Deputy Towns.

17-44638/ Disturbance Domestic (physical)/ Walnut Avenue, Bunnell / A reporting person (RP) reported third party that V1 was slapped by S1. The two parties have a child in common and the dispute started as an argument over custody. V1 could only be reached by phone and did not
