### Part One UCR Crimes: Type of Call / Case Number / Address / Case Summary

Robbery-Home Invasion/46949-17/Richmond Drive, Palm Coast/ Zone 4/Three suspects all armed with handguns forced entry through the front door of the victim's home. Once inside, the suspects ordered an adult male and female and child on the ground. One suspect pistol whipped the adult male in the face, causing minor injury. K9 was utilized, met with negative results.

Disturbance Domestic/46971-17/ Beach Village Drive, Palm Coast/ Zone 5/ Victim 1 (V1) advised that she and Suspect 1 (S1) got into an argument. The argument escalated when S1 slapped V1 in the face. V-1 stated that S1 grabbed her by the throat and choked off her airway. He fled the residence in V1's car. S1 was located and arrested for felony domestic battery a few hours later.

Follow-up/39087-17/Seminole County Sheriff's Office/At approximately 3:53 AM our communications division advised that they received a Teletype from Seminole County Sheriff's Office which stated that a semi-automatic pistol which was stolen out of our county on May 9, 2017 was located. The pistol was recovered as a result of a traffic stop located in Sanford, FL and the driver of the vehicle was arrested. The firearm was entered into evidence at the Sanford Police Department.

Death/47017-17/Hickory Street, Bunnell/ Zone 7/ Woman was found deceased by her boyfriend when their alarm clock sounded this morning. No prior medical history and nothing suspicious observed.
