Part One UCR Crimes: Type of Call / Case Number / Address / Case Summary

Follow up / Zone 2/ Flamingo Drive, Palm Coast. A search of the residence for Suspect 1 (S1) Justin Campbell was conducted after the victim was released from the hospital and allowed FCSO units in the residence. Contact via telephone was conducted with S1 and it was discovered that he was heading to Daytona Beach. A teletype was sent to VCSO and was located by VCSO units on Neptune Dr/S.R. A1A in Ormond Beach. Dep. L Dawson picked up S1 and transported him to Volusia Branch Jail.
