Steps for making Parents/Guardians aware of Opt-Out Process

1. All schools will send a paper-copy of the opt-out form home with the students approximately 3 weeks before the lessons are scheduled to be completed. The school will highlight the grade appropriate portion of the form and the deadline for the return of the form.
2. A digital opt-out form will also be sent through Skyward email to all parents (also highlighting the lesson and deadline date).
3. A Robo-call will be provided to parents making them aware of the upcoming lesson and the process for opting-out.
4. Middle and High School classes should include a statement in their syllabi/ welcome letter explaining the state statute 1003.42 and the part of HB 241 allowing them to opt-out of the portion of the comprehensive health education relating to sex education instruction in acquired immune deficiency syndrome education or any instruction regarding sexuality.
5. Opt-out information will be added to the District and school websites.
