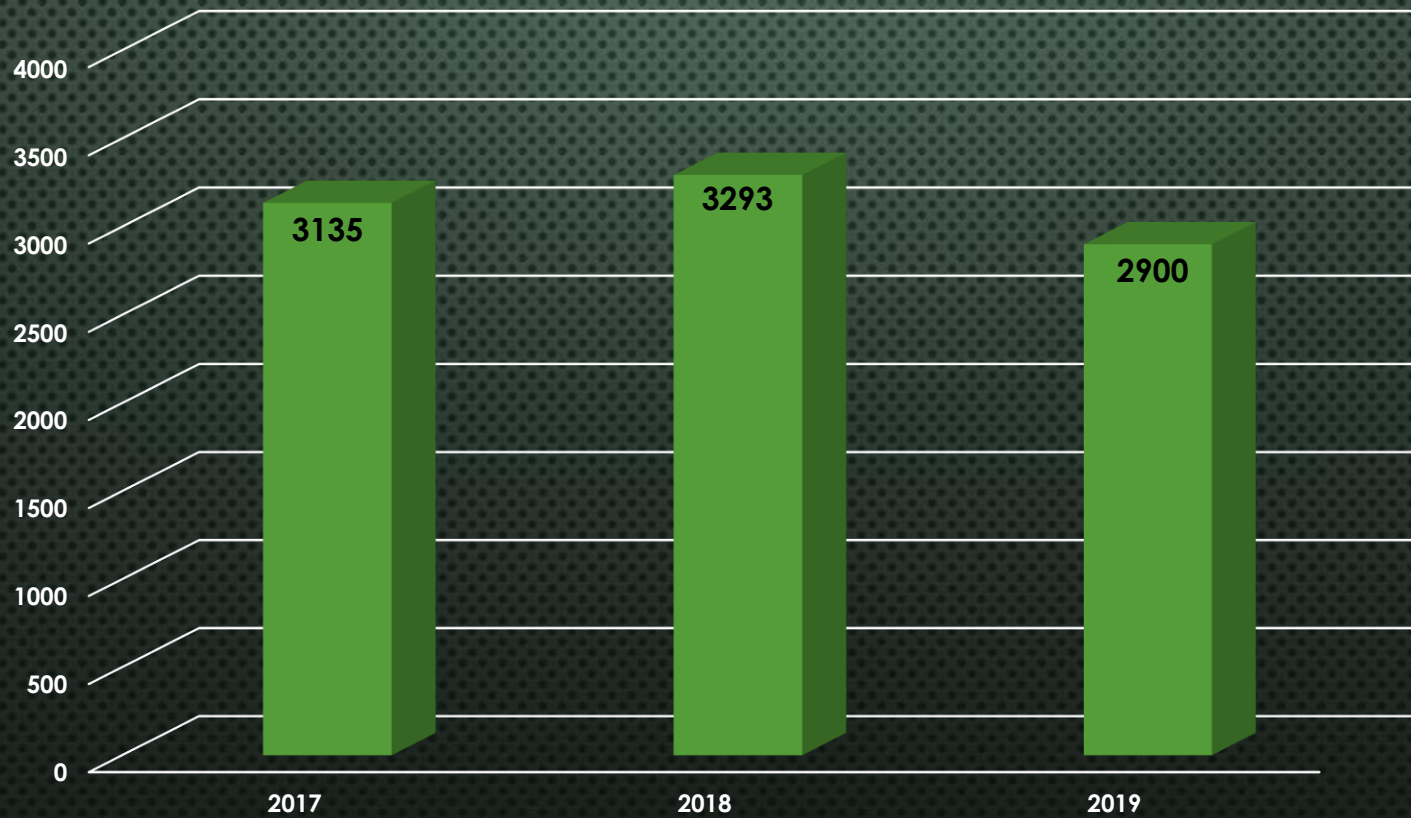

COUNTYWIDE- YTD TOTAL CASES



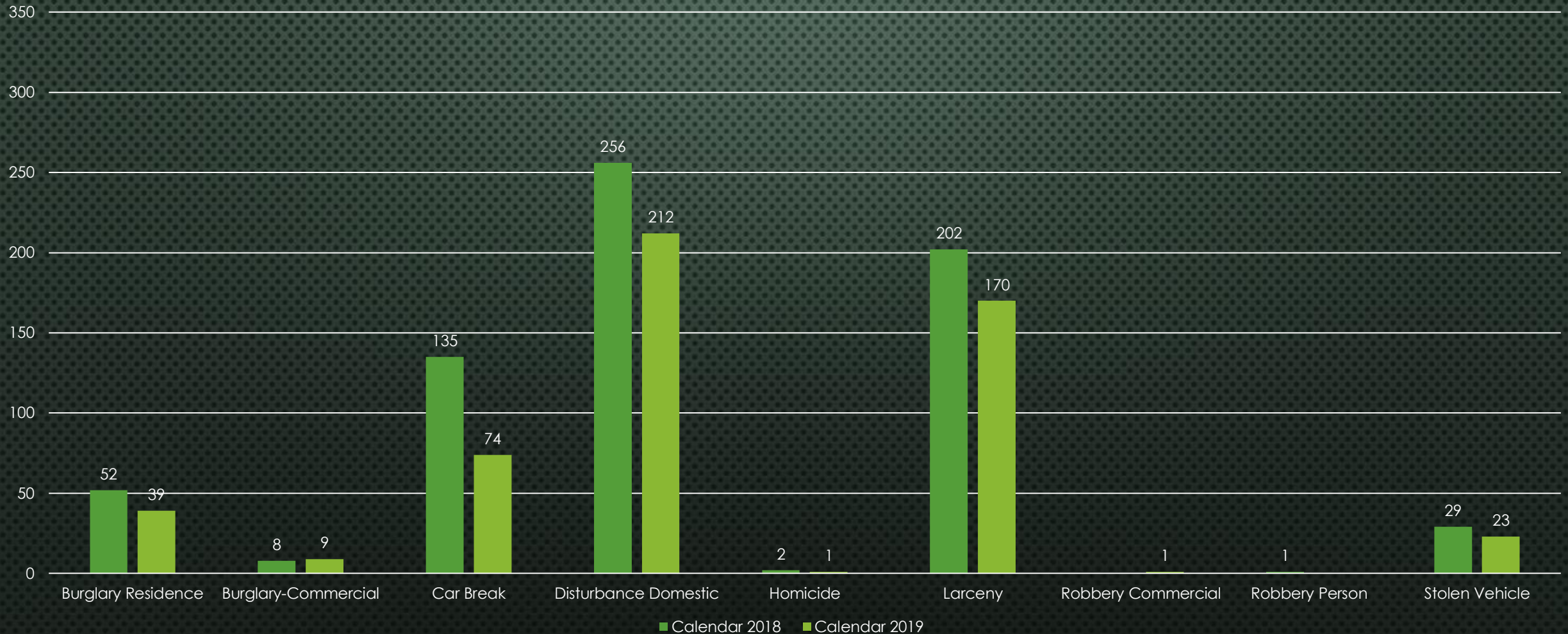

ISD – DV CASE EXAMPLE – SERGEANT MILLER

- Victim fled from residence to local domestic violence shelter after Petrillo threatened her life
- Per the victim, he had pulled out a shotgun from under the bed, pointed it at her head, and said he would "put a bullet in her."
- Petrillo was trespassed from the shelter, but returned to the area (not crossing the property line) and was driving within sight of the building
- Detectives conducted a traffic stop and interviewed Petrillo, who gave inconsistent statements
- Charged with: aggravated domestic battery by strangulation, aggravated domestic assault, domestic battery, and possession of a firearm by a convicted felon
- Ankle monitor to be issued as part of pre-trial release conditions pending release from jail

- Numerous nuisance & narcotics complaints received
- Two vehicles associated with this residence fled & later returned to the residence
- One of the vehicles had been reported stolen
- Written consent obtained to enter home in an attempt to identify the driver
- Upon entry, evidence in plain view gave probable cause to obtain a warrant
- Methamphetamine, the stolen vehicle, & a stolen gun were recovered – four subjects arrested

Recommendation: Increase patrols & traffic stops, maintain contact with code enforcement

- Through collaboration, Report Review continues to move toward elevating the report writing process prior to submitting to the SAO.

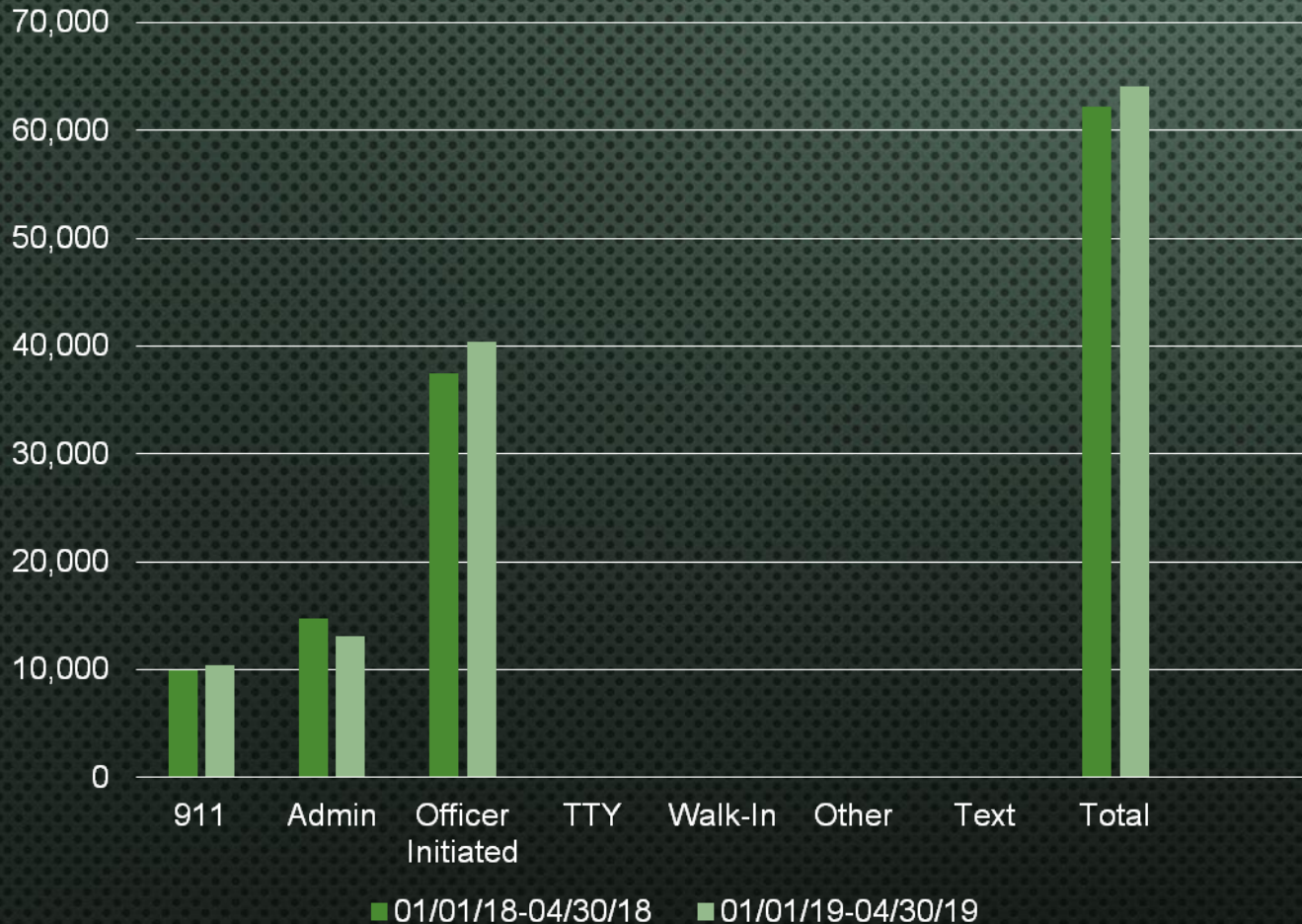

RECORDS UNIT— JUVENILE 707 TYPE— WENDEE HARTMAN



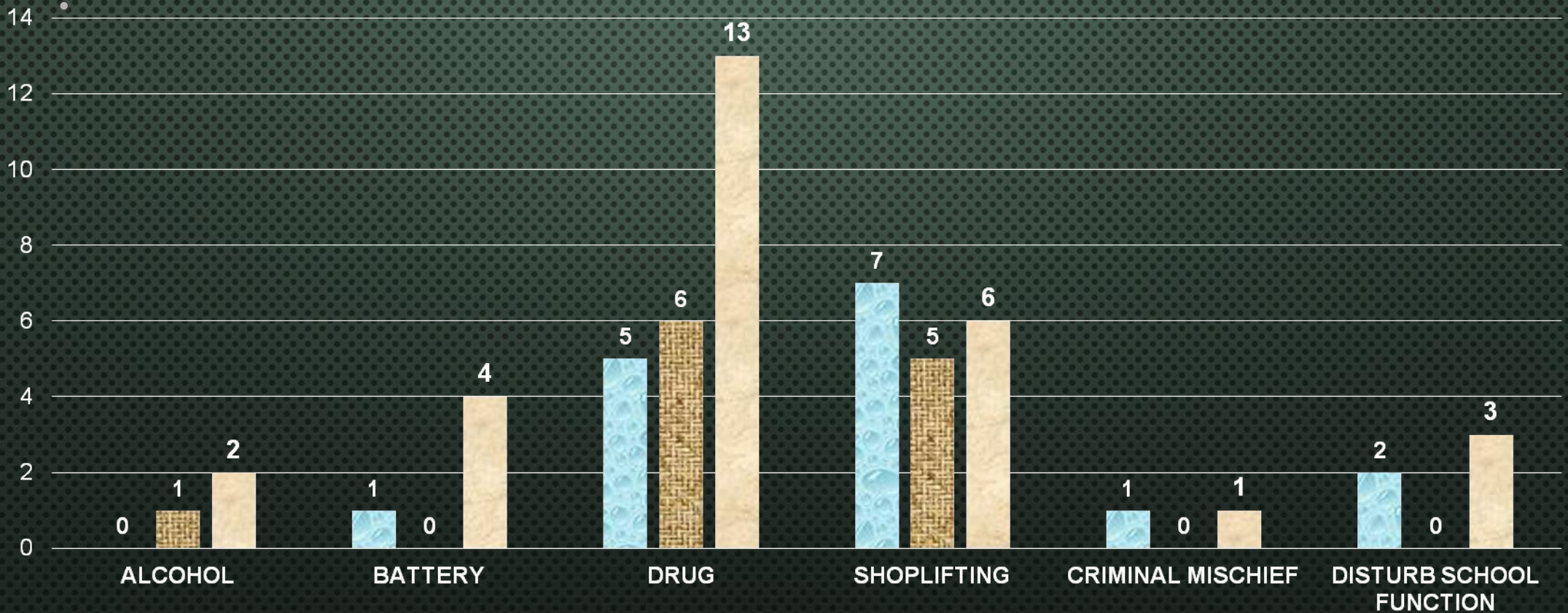
