<b>Death (Suicide)</b>	20-3434	Fairways Circle	Family members woke up and located O1 deceased in the living room. The apartment was cleared and crime scene established.
<b>Domestic Disturbance</b>	20-3533	Fairways Circle	S1 was placed under for DV battery and DV Assault after contact was made with V1. V1 provided statements that S1 grabbed her and threatened her while she was locked in her vehicle. Report by Dep. Held
<b>Physical Disturbance</b>	20-3506	Penndale Pl	RP calling in advising her son grabbed her arms and hurt her. She stated that he is an alcoholic and becomes violent when he drinks. She stated he went out for cigarettes and came home with a bottle of alcohol. When she confronted him, he became angry and grabbed her arms and took her cell phone so she could not call the police. Contact made with male in his room. Male taken into custody for domestic battery. Injuries on RP were photographed and will be submitted. Male transported to the Green Roof Inn.
