TS	20-4076	SR 100 @ Old Kings Rd	Deputies attempted a traffic stop on a red in color Ford F-150. The vehicle fled NB on Old Kings Rd to Town Center Blvd before entering the Lehigh Trail, almost striking bicyclists. Units did not pursue the vehicle but were able to intercept the vehicle on the Lehigh Tr at Belle Terre Pkwy. The driver (S1) bailed from the vehicle and a perimeter was established and FireFlight responded. Deputies located the male off East Hampton Blvd where he fled on foot through the golf course area. The male was taken into custody and provided a false name while he was detained. The vehicle was determined to be stolen out of NC. S1 was placed under arrest reference DWLS w/ knowledge, GTA, Reckless driving, Resist w/o, Flee and Elude, and false name while detained.
