Police Vehicle Damage	20-6586	Seminole Woods Parkway	Unmarked 2018 vehicle struck a deer that ran out onto the roadway. No injuries / No tow service.
Burglary Residence	20-6050	Roxbury Lane	RP reported a delayed burglary that occurred on Sunday, January 19th. This morning, RP noticed a 40" TV missing from the spare room and a screen was removed from a window she leaves open for her cats. Dep. Schmidt completed case report and will follow-up.
Domestic Disturbance	20-6693	Poinsettia Lane	RP reported that she observed S1 hit V1. RP was unable to control the situation and threatened to call 911. S1 then deprived RP from calling by grabbing the phone from her hand. S1 appeared to be very confused and family stated he has been suffering from dementia. Due to S1's age and condition, he was placed under a Baker Act. Charges forwarded on S1 for DV battery and tampering with witness (depriving someone from reporting a crime).
Baker Act	20-6704	Matanzas High School	Juvenile female placed under a Baker Act.
Disturbance Physical	20-6765	Pickering Drive	S1 was arrested for child abuse after a confrontation between neighbors. S1 slapped a phone out of the hand of one of the juveniles. Contact was made with juvenile's parents who wished to press charges. Report made by Dep. Schmidt.
Assault/Battery	20-6681	SR 100 (McDonalds)	V1 and V2 reported that a male attacked them in the parking lot with a baseball bat after a verbal exchange inside McDonalds. V1 stated he commented that he liked the male's Batman sweatshirt and the male became enraged. The male began to videotape them and then grabbed a baseball bat from his vehicle. The male swung the bat in a close proximity to them and then threw a coin from the vehicle, which struck V1 in the forehead causing an abrasion. The male left prior to our arrival and a BOLO was issued for his vehicle. Deputy S. Smith recognized the vehicle and identified S1 from previous encounters. A photo line-up was presented to both victims and they both identified S1 as the suspect. Dep. Ocampo completed a 707 charging affidavit for two counts of aggravated assault and one count of battery.
