Juvenile Complaint	19-6729	Zebulah's Trail and Zaun Trail	6-year-old student was removed from the bus and two plastic toy guns were located in her backpack. The 6-year-old stated she forgot to remove them from her back pack. The juvenile was turned over to her Mother who arrived on scene.
Domestic Disturbance	19-6693	Fleetwood Drive	RP reported a disturbance involving his neighbors down the street. Contact was made with O1 and O2. No injuries were observed consistent with statements provided. Neither party wished to complete a voluntary statement.

Disturbance Physical	19-6646	Clove Avenue	Units responded to a disturbance between father S1 and adult daughter V1. V1 had a bloody scratch on her face. S1 had a broken bloody fingernail on his right hand. Deputies arrested S1 for battery-DV, and tamper with a victim because he unplugged the phone when she tried to call 911. Charges forwarded to SAO against daughter for battery DV due to the father's allegation that his daughter pushed him several times.
