<b>Burglary Residential</b>	18-96784	Pony Express Drive	V1 reported unknown suspect(s) entered his unsecured garage overnight and stole a kayak, generator, and drill set. V1 could not provide any serial numbers for the items stolen.
<b>Disturbance Domestic</b>	18-96740	Lamar Lane	S1 grabbed V1 and pushed her to the ground during a confrontation. S1 was transported to FCIF and charged with DV Battery.
<b>Disturbance With Weapons</b>	18-96796	18-96796	Third party caller reported a physical disturbance between two males, one of which was in possession of a machete. Upon arrival, the two males had separated. Contact was made with a witness who advised one of the males involved was inside the residence, later identified as O1, and the other, later identified as O2, had already left the scene. According to W1 and O1, a physical altercation occurred between O1 and O2 during which time O2 grabbed a baseball bat and O1 grabbed a large knife. Nothing further ensued and O2 left for an unknown destination. Attempts to made contact with O2 have met with negative results. O1 advised he did not want to pursue charges.
<b>Domestic Disturbance</b>	18-96844/	N Ocean Shore Blvd	O1 and O2 got into in a verbal argument. Both parties advised the argument was verbal in nature. They refused to write statement or have pictures taken.
