<b>Burglary Vehicle</b>	18-94427	Moody Boulevard	V1 advised a Garmin GPS was stolen from his boat between 9/29/18 and today.
<b>Baker Act</b>	18-94425	Yacht Harbor Drive	Adult male transported by LEO to Halifax due to being combative.
<b>Drunk Person</b>	18-94404	Yacht Harbor Drive	An intoxicated male had been causing a disturbance at the main condo building since approximately 5:00 AM. His behavior caused several residents to contact security and management to complain. While Deputies were on scene he was yelling and verbally combative he was then secured for disorderly conduct. After being arrested he stated that he wanted to kill himself and was subsequently Baker Acted (Case #2018-94425).
<b>Commercial Burglary</b>	18-94397	Palm Harbor Village Way (Smiles)	Side door on the two side of the building was smashed out and entry was made into the business. A gaming machine was broken open and unknown amount of cash/coins was taken from the machine.

<b>Domestic Disturbance</b>	18-93368	Plaza Drive	S1 was involved in a physical altercation with his adult son. S1 struck v1 with a stool outside of Brewster's Ice cream shop causing him to fall to the ground. S1 was arrested in reference to domestic battery.
<b>Domestic Disturbance</b>	18-94419	Forest Park Street	S1 was reported to have head butted and punched V1 several times before V1 began to protect himself. S1 was determined to be the primary aggressor and was arrested for child abuse.
