<b>Burglary Commercial</b>	19- 116250	Palm Coast Parkway	Business owner reported that sometime during the evening last night someone broke into her business. She observed a damaged rear entry door and the filing cabinets had been rummaged through. The floor safe on scene had evidence of attempted forced entry and large gouges from some type of saw. The only item missing at this time is the DVR recorder box.
<b>Burglary Commercial</b>	19-116277	Palm Coast Parkway	Business owner reported that sometime during the evening last night someone broke into her business. Deputies located a side glass door that was completely smashed out. A security system was removed from the front desk area of the store along with blank checks.
<b>Burglary (conveyance)</b>	19-116290	Flagler Plaza Drive	V1 owner reported that sometime during the evening last night someone broke into his black trailer, which was parked behind the business. V1 stated a black backpack containing 4 firearms was stolen: black Sig Sauer P20 .45 caliber semi-automatic handgun, black Kel-Tec .380 caliber semi-automatic handgun, black Ruger P90 9MM semi-automatic handgun, black Ruger .22 caliber semi-automatic handgun.
