<b>Domestic Disturbance-Verbal</b>	19-	Cherokee Ct	Parties are married and have 2 children in common. All parties reside at this address. O1 became angry and started yelling and throwing items around the house. All parties advised the incident was verbal only, and there was no violence or threats of violence by any party involved.
